Equality and Diversity

Views and Experiences of People with learning disability in relation to policing arrangements in Northern Ireland.

Published on 24 August 2011 by The Police Ombudsman's Office and the Northern Ireland Policing Board.

The report is the outcome of a major research project co-funded by the Police Ombudsman's Office and the Policing Board into the issues faced by people with learning disability when dealing with the police and policing organisations. Almost 300 people with learning disability, along with key workers and organisations in the learning disability sector, and representatives of the police, policing organisations and criminal justice bodies were consulted during the project.

The study found that people with learning disability had largely positive views and experiences of the police. But it also found that many instances of bullying and harassment of people with learning disability were likely to go unreported because the victims did not realise that they had been a victim of crime, or were unwilling to report it. The report makes 24 recommendations to help ensure the police and policing organisations respond appropriately to the needs of people with learning disability, and also to help combat disability hate crime.

The research was launched on the morning of 24 August in Clifton House, Belfast. Approximately 70 people attended the launch and speakers included Al Hutchinson, the Police Ombudsman, Conall McDevitt MLA, the chair of the Policing Board's Human Rights and Professional Standards Committee, Maureen Piggott, the Director of Mencap in Northern Ireland and Chief Superintendent Peter Farrar, Deputy Head of PSNI's Criminal Justice Department. The attendees also heard the views of two people with learning disability and the morning ended with a question and answer session. The report is available at:

Quality & Outcomes Framework (QOF) Prevalence Data General Medical Services Contract In Northern Ireland

QOF is a system that was introduced in the UK on 1st April 2004 as a fundamental part of the new General Medical Services (GMS) contract. It is designed to remunerate general practices for providing good quality care to their patients, and to help fund work to further improve the quality of health care delivered. The QOF measures achievement against a range of evidence-based indicators covering: chronic disease management; clinical processes & outcomes; organisational efficiency and patient experience.

As part of the QOF, prevalence registers are maintained and relative practice weightings calculated, which are used to adjust the QOF points awarded to take account of differing levels of various diseases/conditions within each general practice. These calculations are now complete for 31 March 2011 and an accompanying report has been published on the DHSSPS website at the link below:
