## Table Population Bases

---

Results shown in the statistical tables relate to a specified population, such as all people or all households. Information on the table populations of the Migration, Travel to Work and Workplace tables are provided below. Most of the terms used in table populations are defined in the glossary.

### Migration

Migration tables are based on migrants - people with a different address one year before the Census to that on Census Day. The migrant status for children aged under one in households is determined by the migrant status of their 'next of kin' (defined as in order of preference, mother, father, sibling (with nearest age), other related person, Household Reference Person).

The populations used in the Migration tables include:

- All persons resident in Northern Ireland and those having moved from Northern Ireland to elsewhere in the UK in the past year

- All households in Northern Ireland and those having moved from Northern Ireland to elsewhere in the UK in the past year

- All moving group reference persons aged 16 to 74

- All groups of persons within a household who have moved together from the same usual address one year before Census day

- All persons aged 16 to 74 resident in Northern Ireland and those having moved from Northern Ireland to elsewhere in the UK in the past year

### Travel to work

The 2001 Census has been conducted on a usually resident basis. As a result, the vast majority of statistics released from the 2001 Census relate to where people usually live, as opposed to where they are on Census Night or where they work. It is important to recognise that persons who usually live in England, Wales or Scotland but work in Northern Ireland are not resident in Northern Ireland and as such are not included in the Travel to Work tables. Such people will, however, be included in the Workplace Population tables (see overleaf).

The populations used in the Travel to Work tables include:

- All persons aged 16 to 74 in employment

- All households with at least one person working in the week before the Census

- All persons aged 16 to 74 in employment the week before the Census

- All persons aged 16 to 74 in employment

## Workplace population

The workplace population is defined as the people aged 16 to 74 who are in employment and whose usual place of work is in Northern Ireland. Persons who usually live in England, Wales or Scotland but work in Northern Ireland will be included in these tables. Such tables will be clearly marked as having a workplace population base.

While the majority of Workplace Population tables provide information on all persons aged 16 to 74 in employment in the area, some of the tables have been based on alternative population bases.

These alternative population bases include:

- All daytime population aged 16 to 74

- All persons aged 16 to 74 in employment in the area the week before the Census who are not full-time students

- All persons aged 16 to 74 who are either resident in Northern Ireland or work in Northern Ireland

- All persons resident in the area aged 16 to 74
