Dear Occupier,

The Northern Ireland Statistics & Research Agency (NISRA) runs the Census every 10 years to collect data on people and housing. The information produced is important for the planning and funding of public services in your community, such as transport, education and health.

NISRA use a list of addresses derived from a range of public bodies to prepare for a successful Census. During October NISRA staff will be checking the information we hold in your area. This will involve our staff carrying out a visual check of properties to verify that the address details we hold are correct. We are not concerned with who lives at the address but simply whether the address characteristics match those that we hold.
