The CSO's main areas of interest are: 1. Ireland and Northern Ireland joint publication 2021 2. Commuting data between Ireland and Northern Ireland CSO regularly meets with colleagues in NISRA to discuss census content and where possible explore coherency of approach. Topics to be covered in the publication will be agreed by both organisations prior to publication. As part of the regular discussions with NISRA, CSO will keep abreast of approaches being undertaken to SDC for 2021 data. As has been done for Census 2016, CSO will also produce information from Census 2021 on persons who are usually resident in Ireland and commute to Northern Ireland. This will involve coding the place of work school or college of these commuters.
