EU Exit – Trade Analysis

NI ← Ireland (IE)

Broad Economy Sales and Exports Statistics (BESES) 2018 (Goods & Services)

- NI total exports to IE 1 by £330m (8.6%) over the year to £4.2bn during 2018.
- IE is NI's **single largest export market** in terms of individual countries. (NB sales to GB are not classified as exports exports relate to sales outside of the UK).
- Exports to IE equate to 6% of all sales by NI businesses.
- 46% (£1,912m) of NI exports to IE can be attributed to 93% (8,059) of all micro and small businesses (i.e. those with less than 50 employees).

HMRC Regional Trade Statistics (RTS) 2018 (Goods only)

Exports

- £3.2bn goods were exported from NI to IE
- Top 2 exports:
 - 1. Food & Live Animals 32% (£1.0bn)
 - 2. Machinery & Transport Equipment 16% (£528m)

Imports

- £2.2bn goods were imported from IE to NI
- Top 2 imports:
 - 1. Food & Live Animals 41% (£897m)
 - 2. Manufactured Goods Classified Chiefly by Material 15% (£326m)

Cross-Border Supply Chain Survey 2015, 2016

- 758,000 export deliveries to IE worth £3.4bn in 2016.
- 410,000 import deliveries in 2015 from IE to NI businesses worth nearly £2.0bn.
- Majority of cross-border transactions made by **micro and small businesses** which dominate NI economy.
- 39% of NI trade (exports and imports) in goods with IE is comprised of trade of "intermediate" goods i.e. a product used by a business in the production of their output.

BESES 2018 (Goods & Services)

 NI sales to GB ↓ by £1.1bn (9.3%) over the year to £10.6bn during 2018.

NI Great Britain (GB)

- GB remained the most significant single market for external sales (i.e. sales outside NI) from NI businesses, accounting for 15.4% of total sales.
- **76%** (£7,998m) of sales to GB can be attributed to **7%** (589) of medium/large businesses (i.e. businesses with more than 50 employees).

BESES 2018 (Purchases & Imports)

- Purchases of goods and services from GB were estimated to be worth £13.4bn to by 1.4% (£0.2bn) and accounted for 29% of total purchases.
- 63% (£6.5bn) of goods purchased by NI businesses from GB businesses were aimed at the NI Wholesale and Retail Sector.
- 72% (£9,663m) of purchases from GB were made by medium/large businesses (i.e. businesses with more than 50 employees); 825 medium/ large businesses (6%) of a total of 13,005 NI businesses purchasing from GB.

NB No HMRC data available for NI:GB trade as HMRC only records trade activity outside of the UK

BESES 2018 (Goods & Services)

• NI exports to REU (excluding IE) 1 over the year by £425m (20.9%) to £2.5bn during 2018.

NI ← Rest of EU (REU) / Rest of World (ROW)

NI exports to ROW to by £82m (1.8%) over the year to £4.5bn.

 - 1. Machinery & Transport Equipment 52% (£1.8bn)
 - 2. Chemicals & Related Products, n.e.s 20% (£700m)

Imports from ROW

- £2.7bn goods were imported from ROW
- Top 2 imports:
 - 1. Machinery & Transport Equipment 35% (£949m)
 - 2. Miscellaneous Manufactured Articles 24% (£669m)
