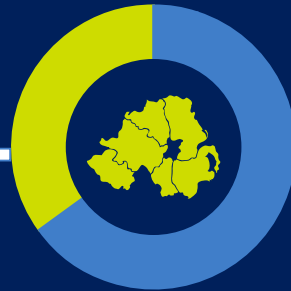


Loneliness in Northern Ireland 2019/20

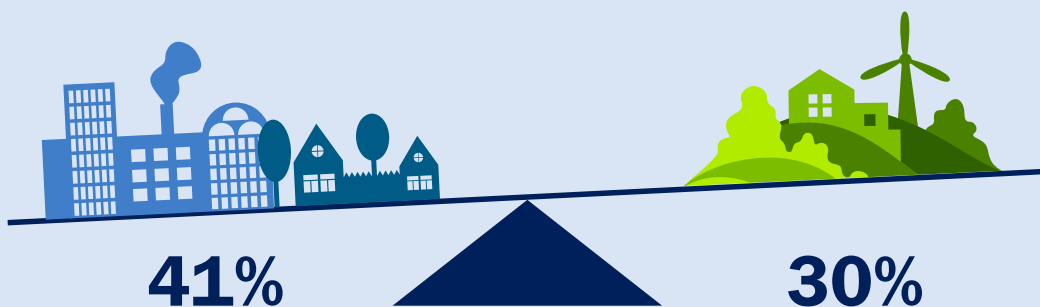
