Please note that the figures presented in this document relate to overseas visitors exiting through a Northern Ireland air/sea port. Overseas visitors, who stay at least one night in Northern Ireland, exiting through a port in the Republic of Ireland are not included. Historically these visitors account for approximately 30% of overseas visitors to Northern Ireland. A separate bulletin will be published reporting total overseas visitors to Northern Ireland once the data on visitors who exit via a Republic of Ireland port become available.

Overseas visitors to Northern Ireland (NI) January-March 2011

During January-March 2011, an estimated 205,000 overseas visitors stayed at least one night in NI, an increase of 7% from the same period in 2010.

The estimated expenditure of the overseas visitors during the period in 2011 was £48m, an increase of 14% from the same period in 2010.

The proportion of visitors visiting friends and relatives in NI, increased by 6 percentage points, representing 61% of all visitors in Jan-Mar 2011. The proportion of visitors on holiday in NI, decreased by 3 percentage points from 2010.

Background

Information on **overseas visitors** to NI is collected through the Northern Ireland Passenger Survey (NIPS). The survey methodology may be viewed at:

Overseas visitors include anyone reporting their country of residence as outside Northern Ireland or Republic of Ireland. The estimates published in this report refer to those overseas visitors who stayed at least one night in Northern Ireland and exited Northern Ireland via one of the air or sea ports.

Sampling variability

The NIPS is a sample survey and estimates obtained from it are subject to sampling variability. Table 3 details the confidence intervals of the visitor estimates by country of residence for January – March 2011.
