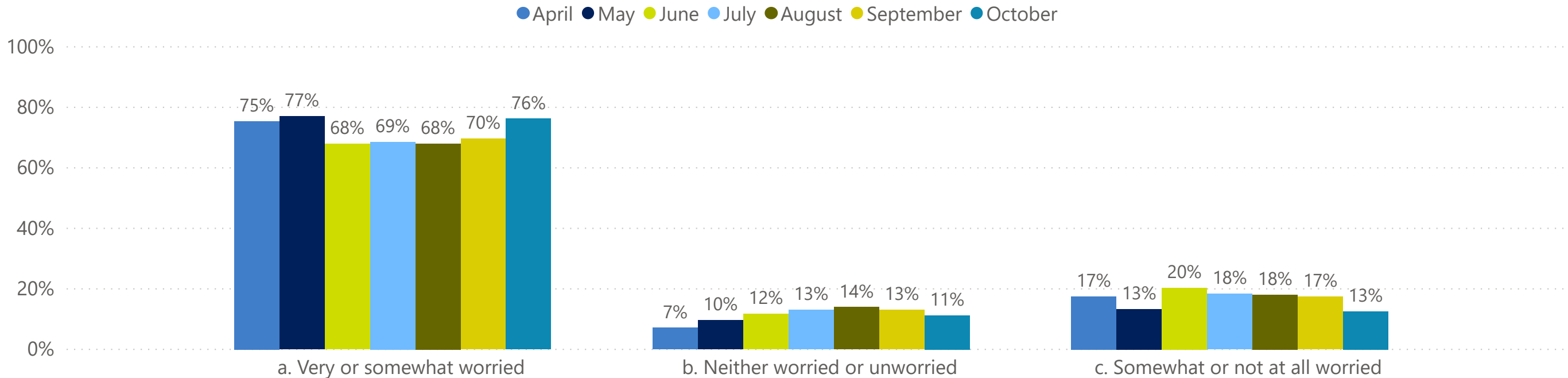

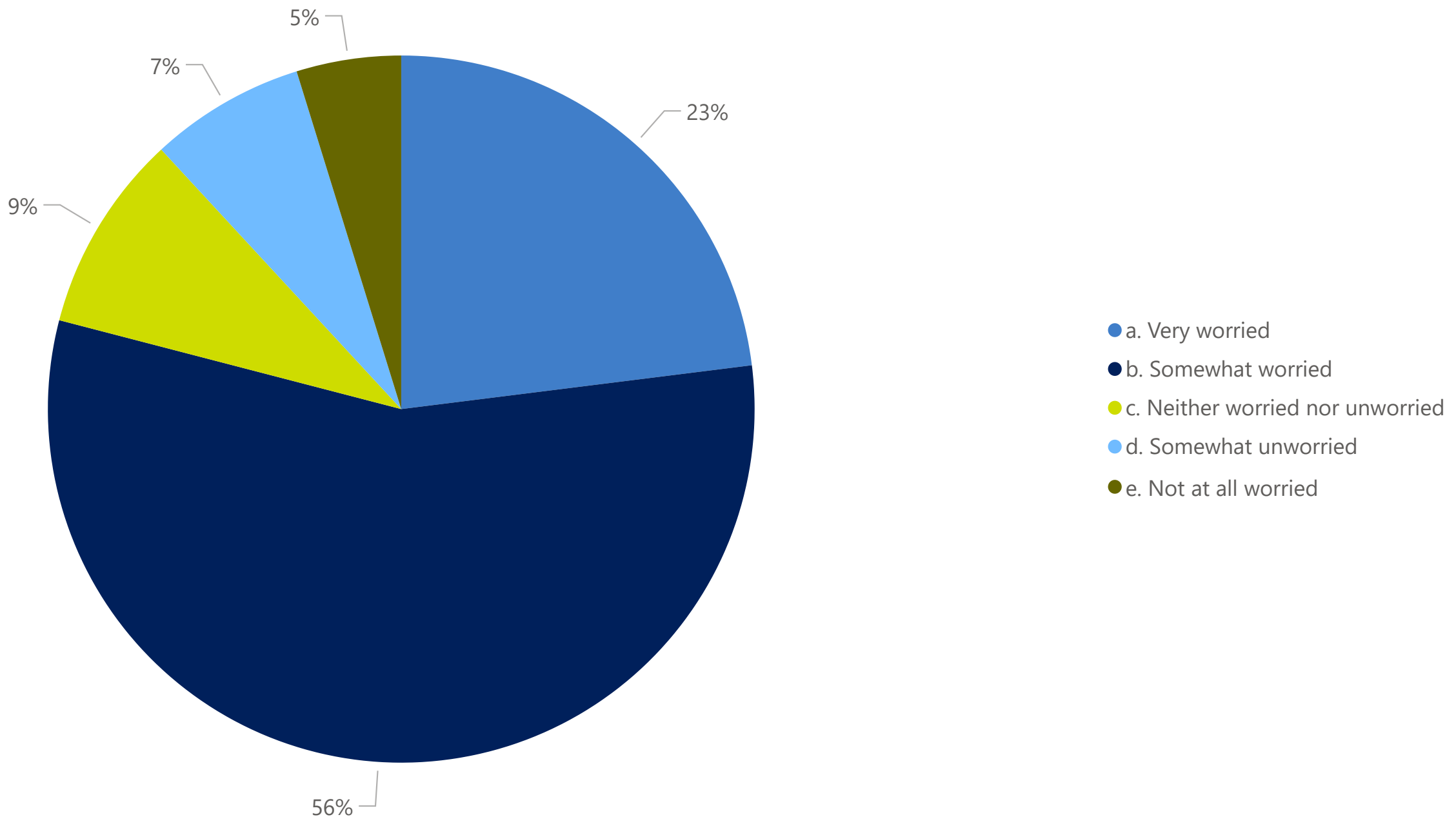
COV_C9: How worried or unworried are you about the effect that Coronavirus (Covid-19) is having on your life right now?... Overall



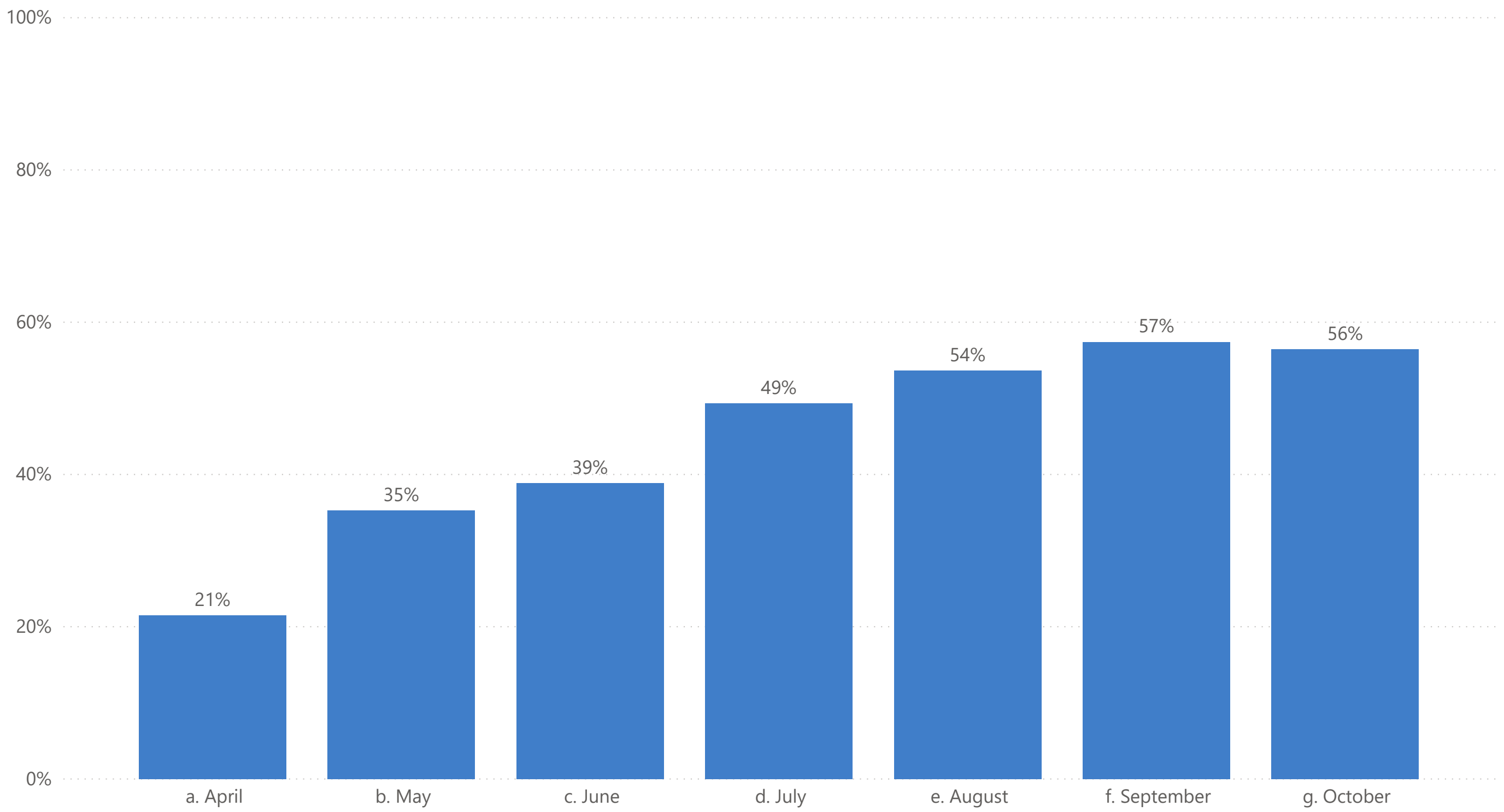
COV_C9; How worried or unworried are you about the effect that Coronavirus (COVID-19) is having on your life right now?... by month of interview



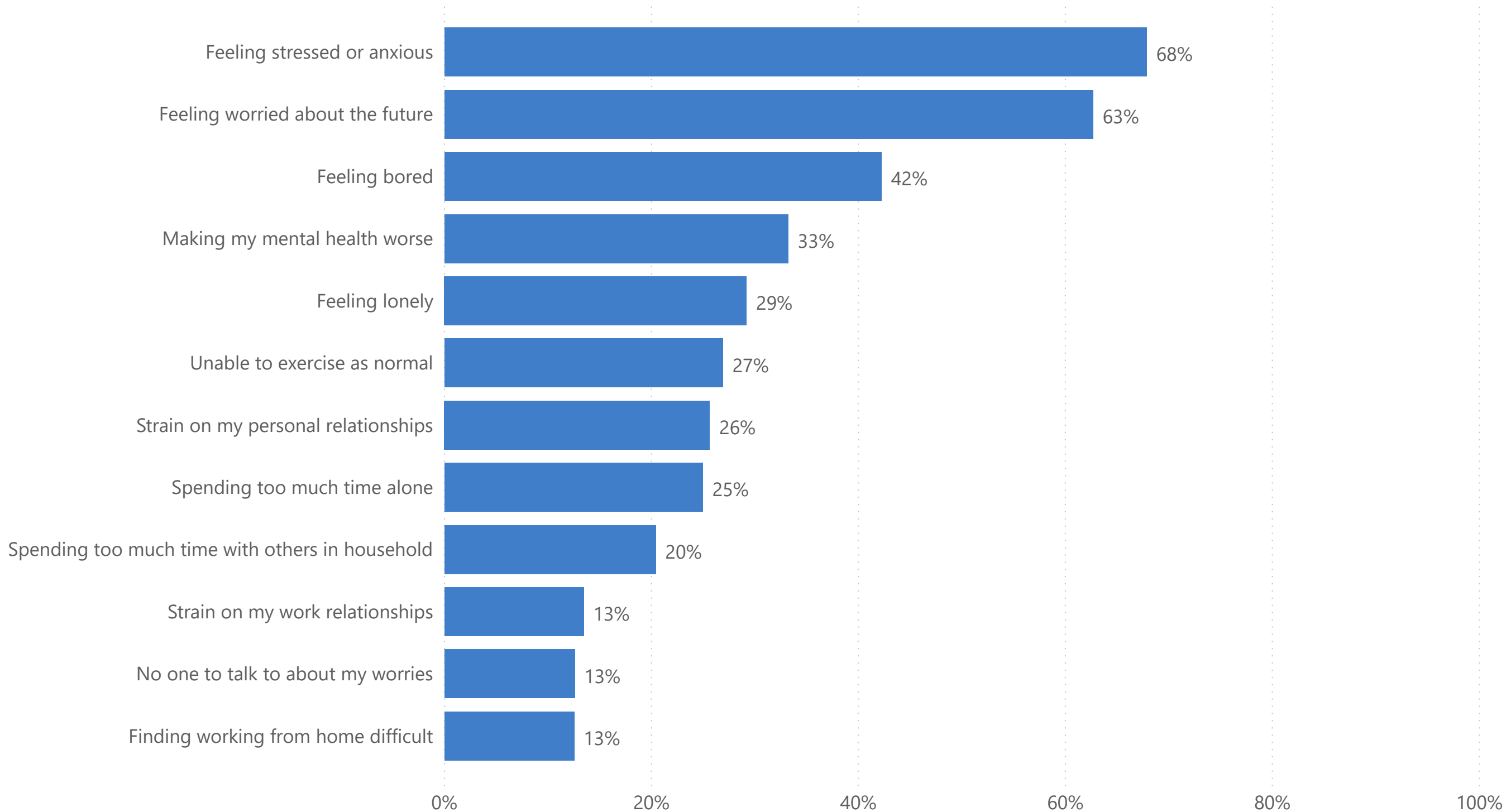
COV_C31: How worried or unworried are you that Coronavirus (COVID-19) is affecting your friends and family?

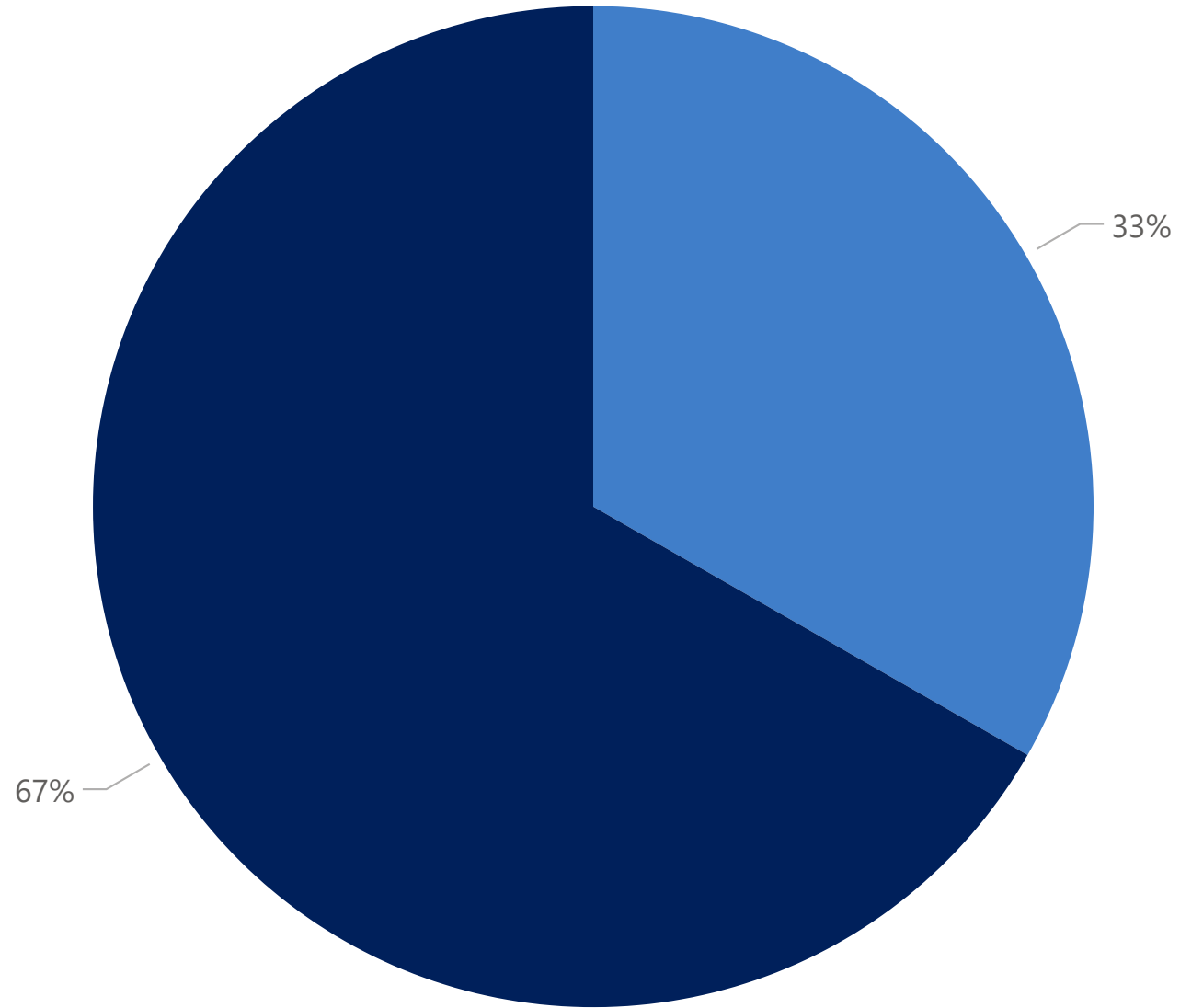

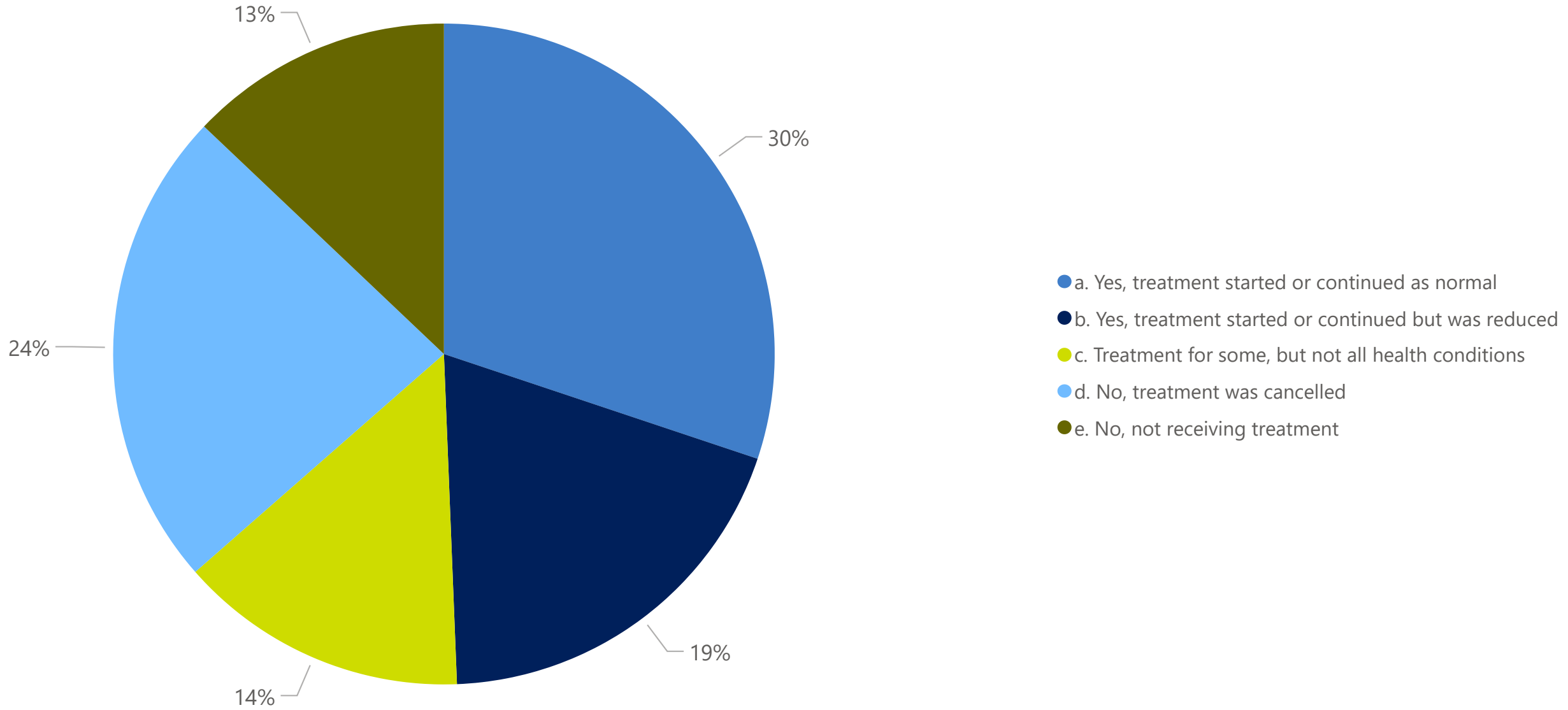

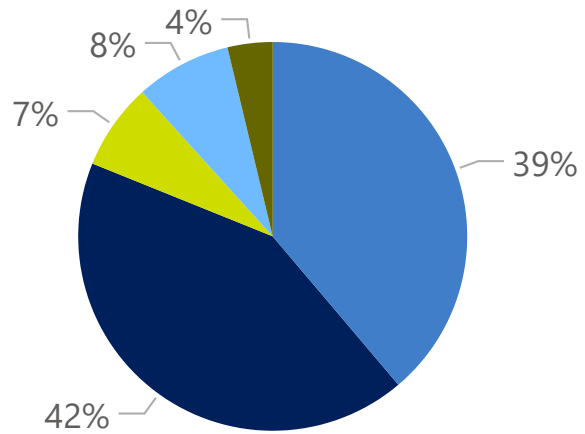

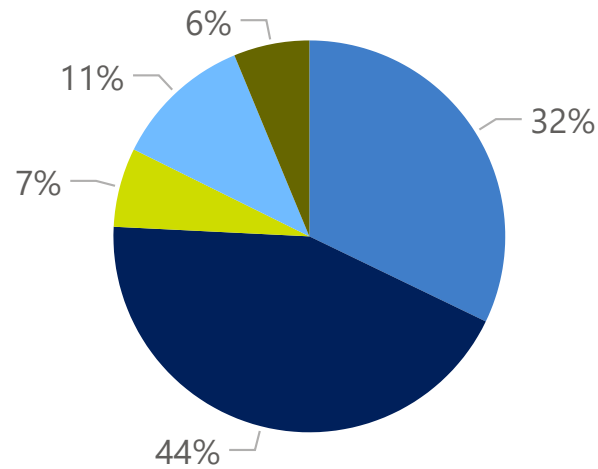

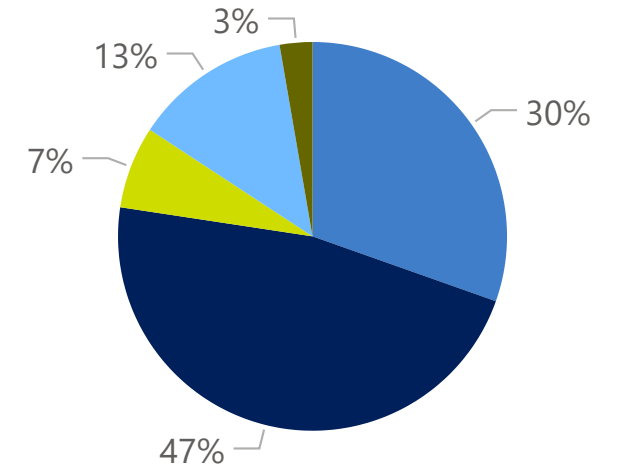

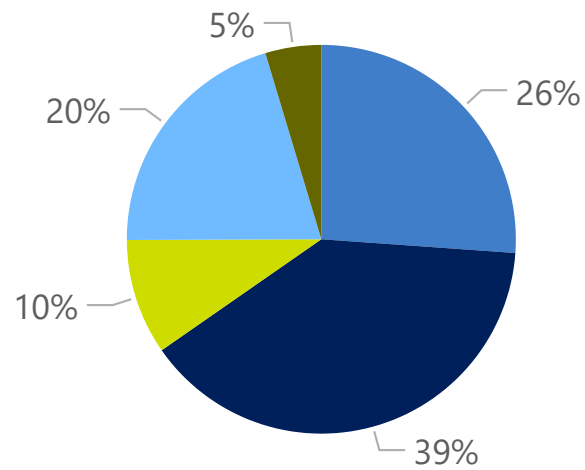

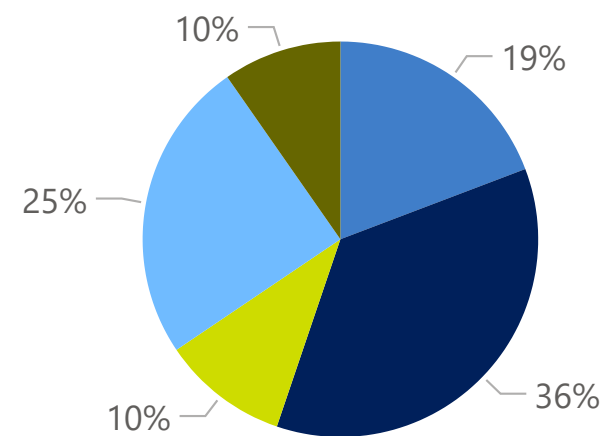

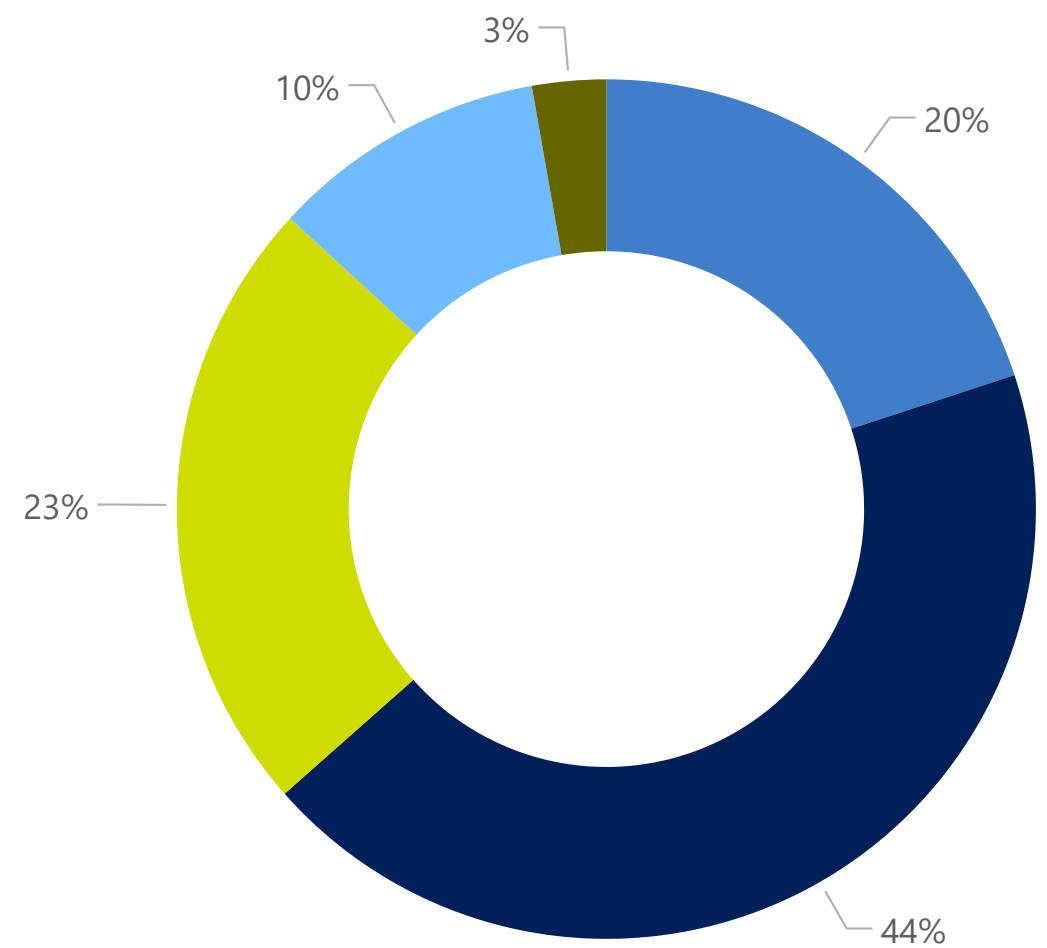

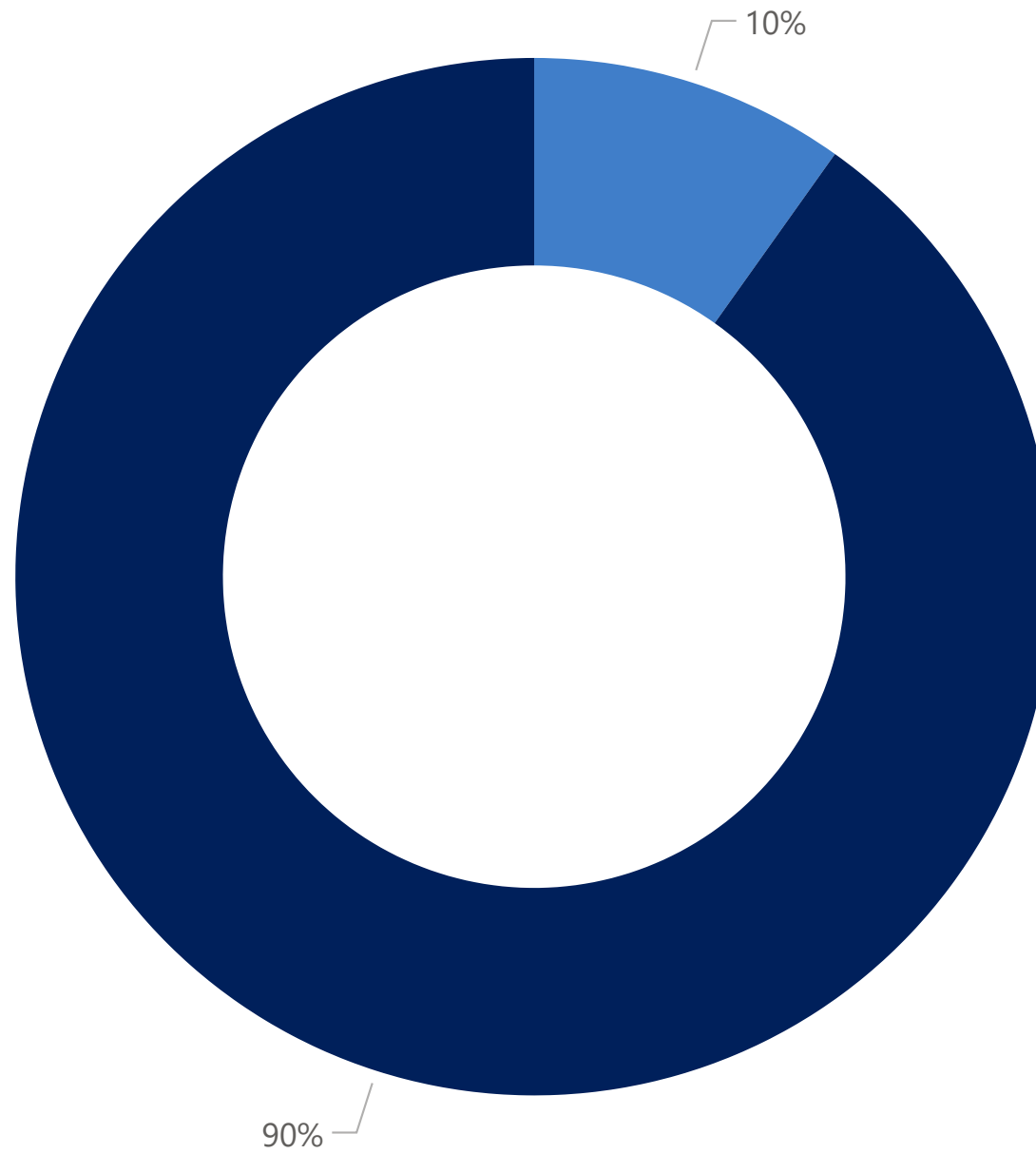

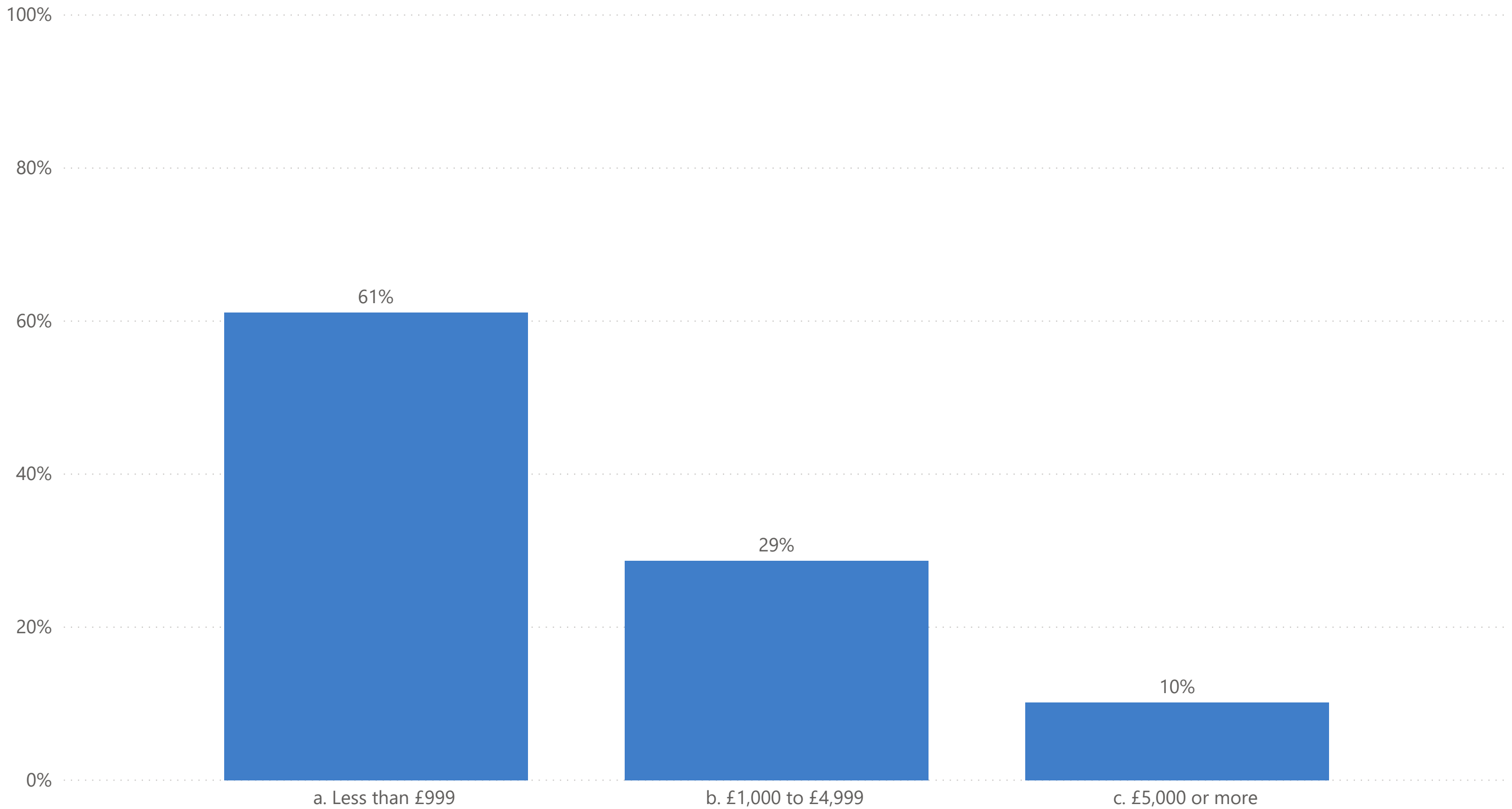

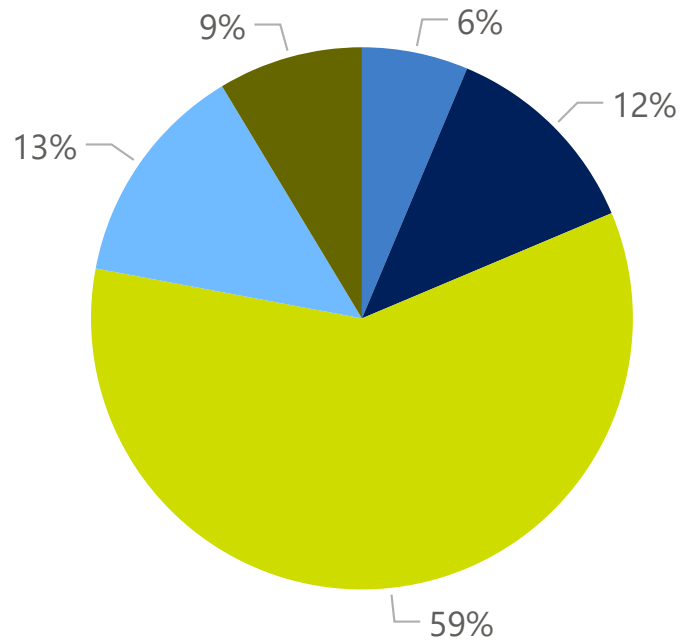

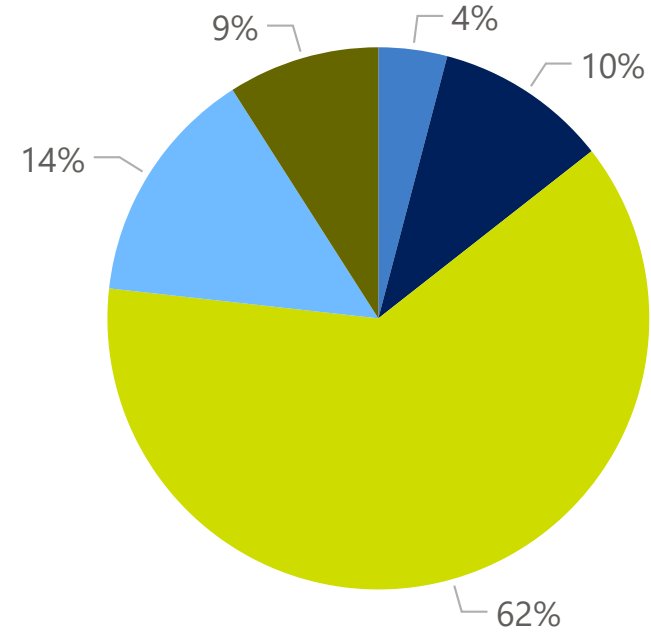

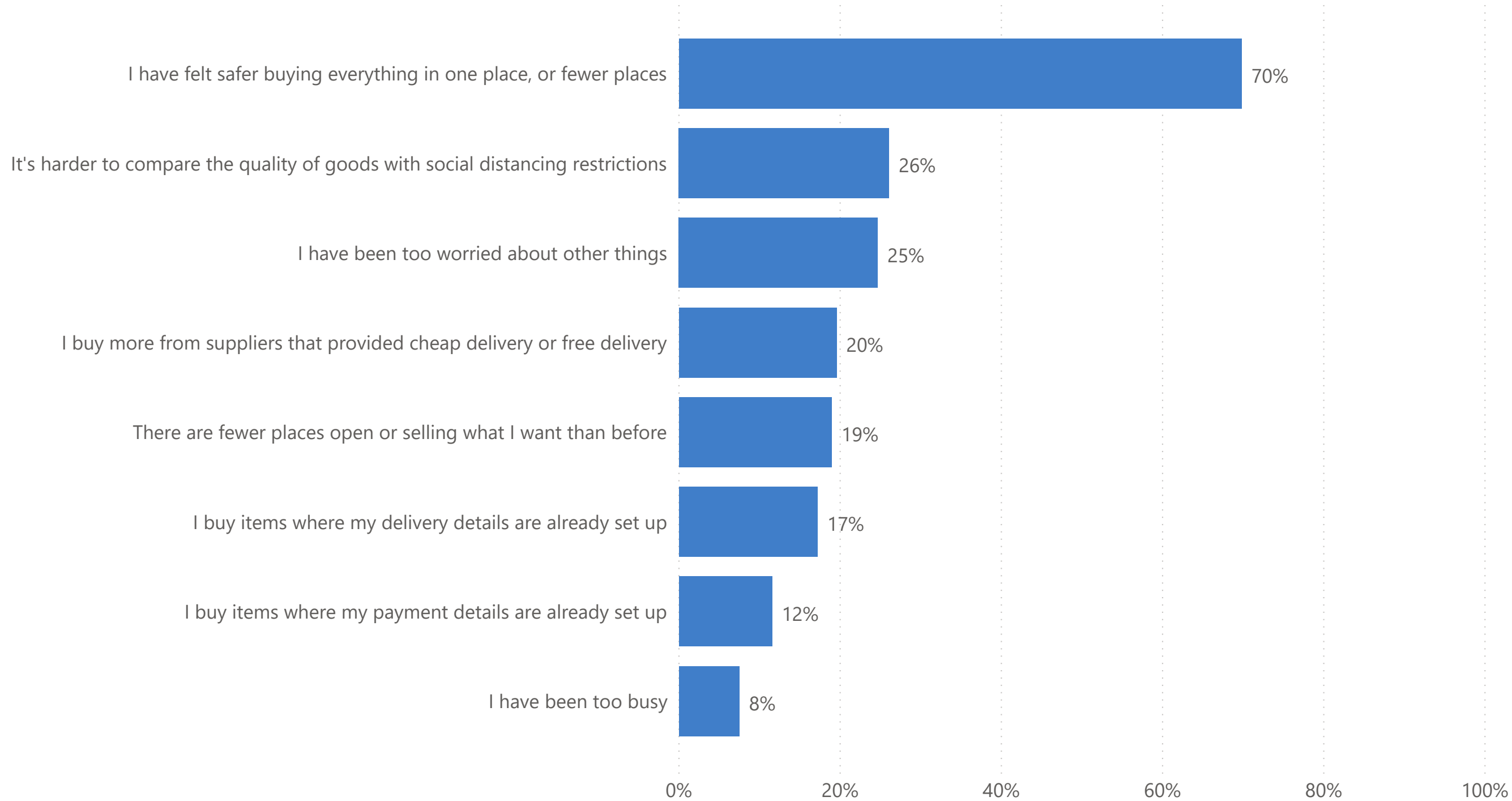

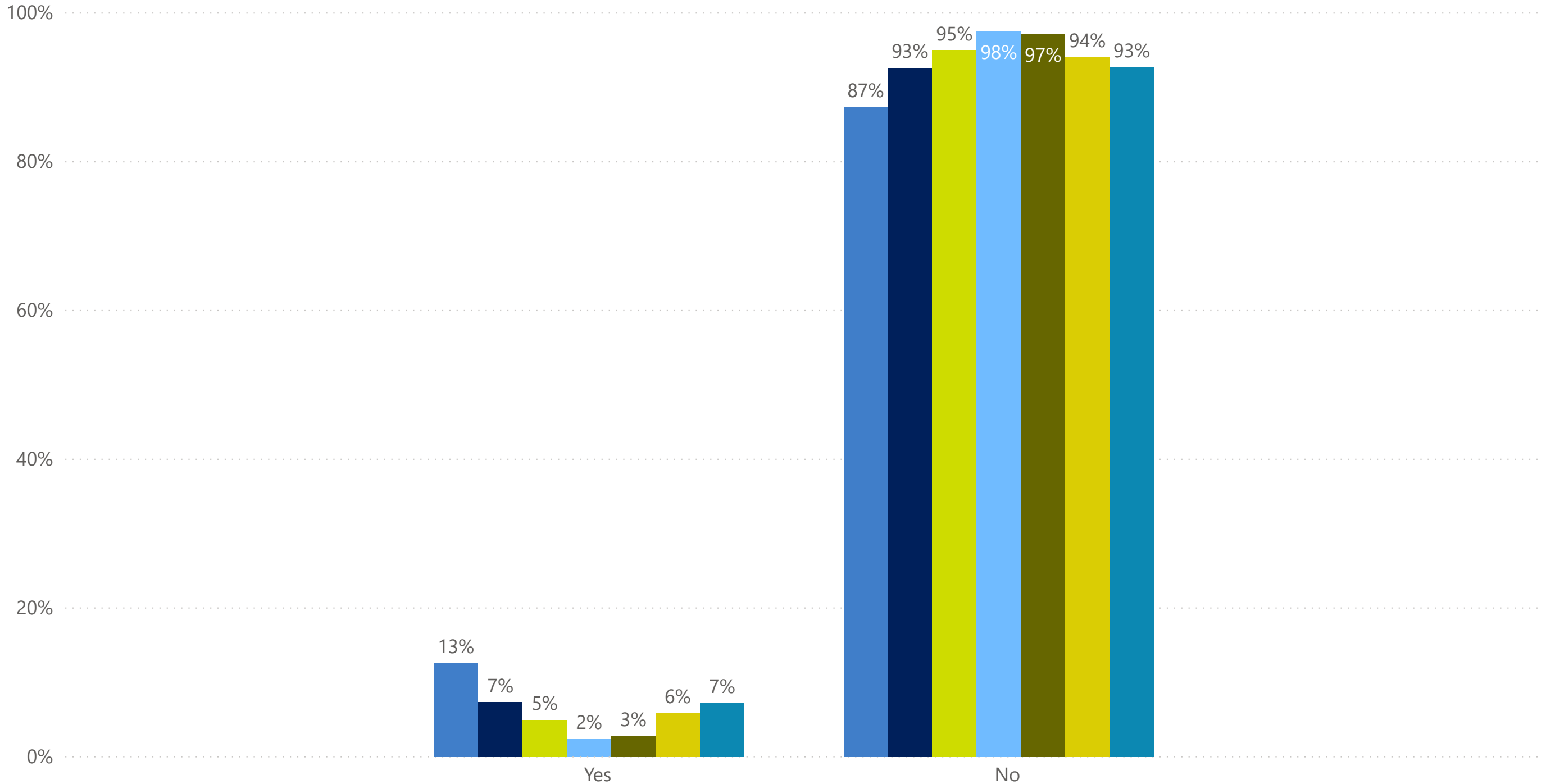

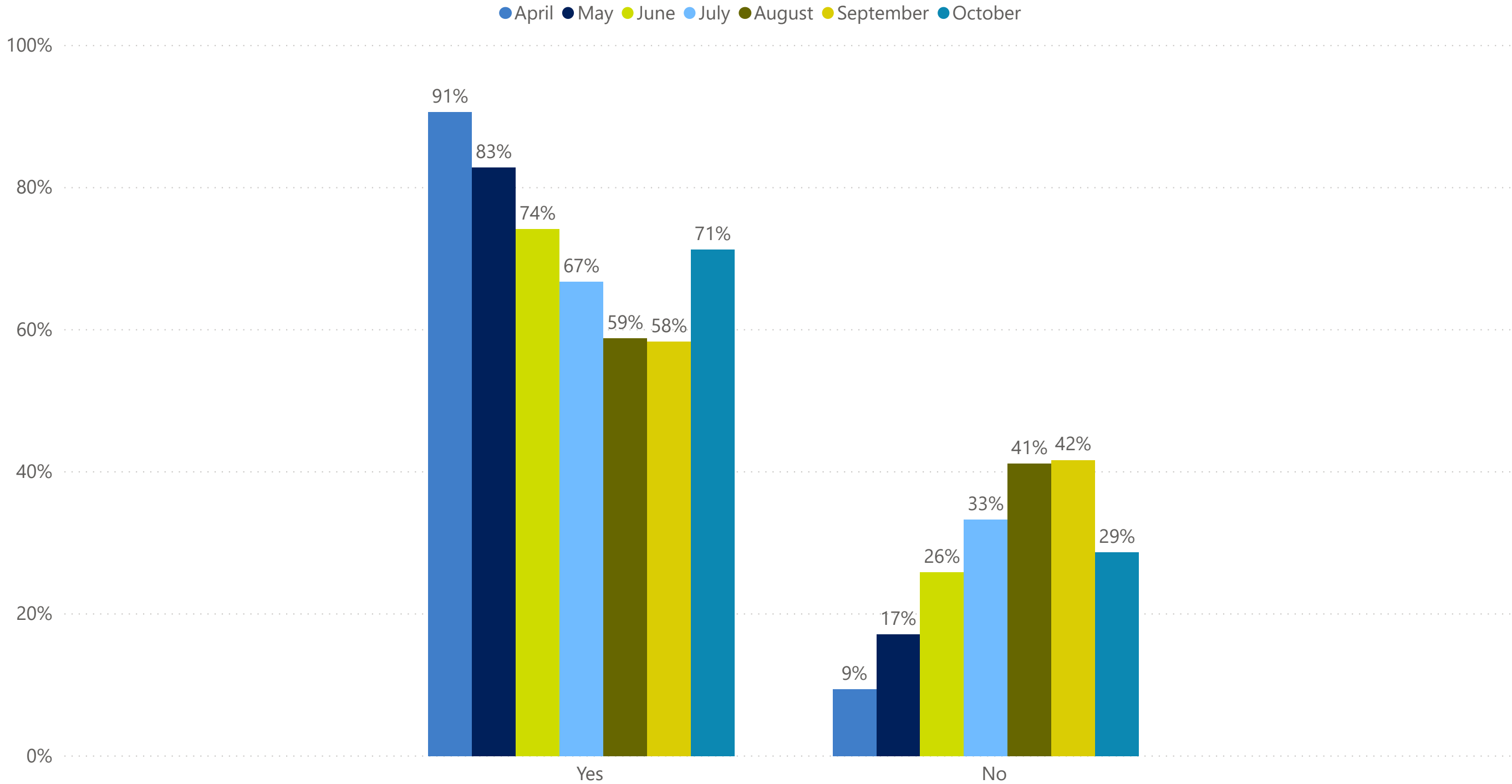

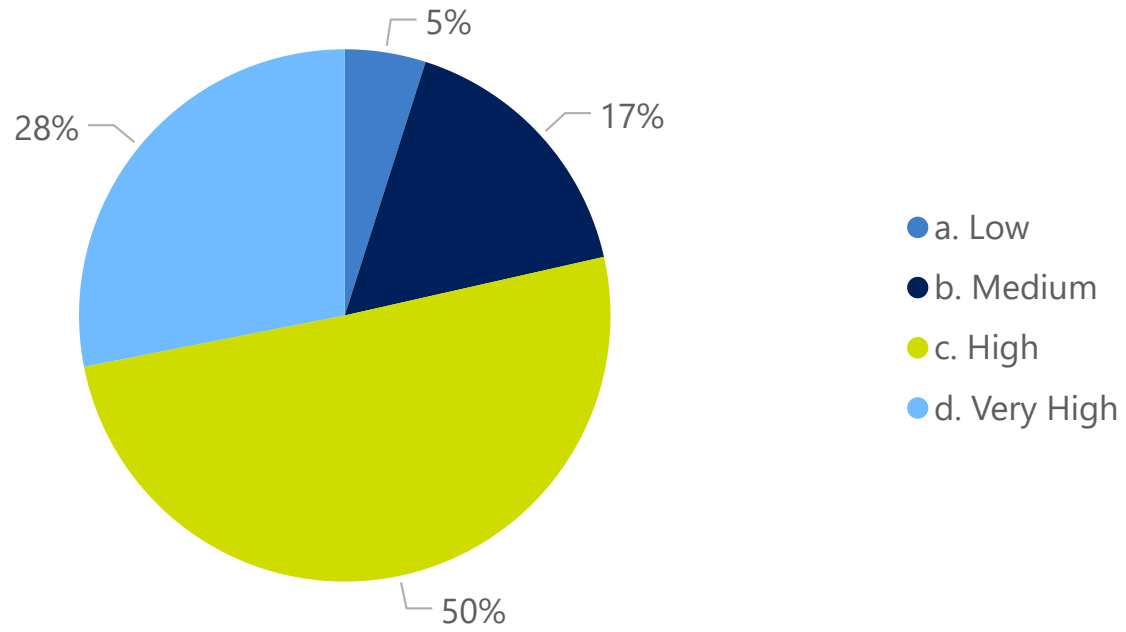

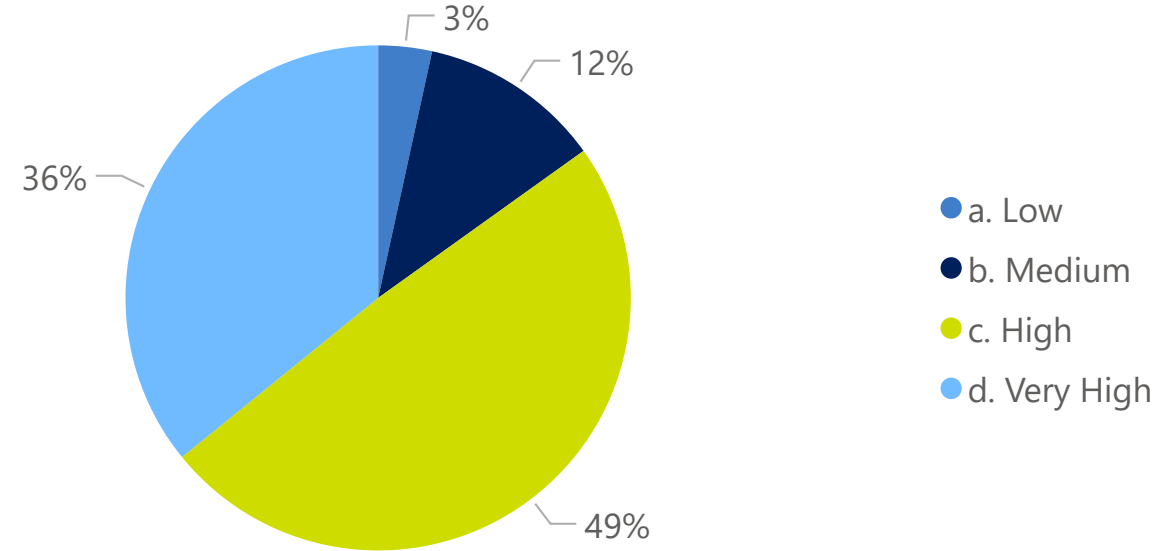

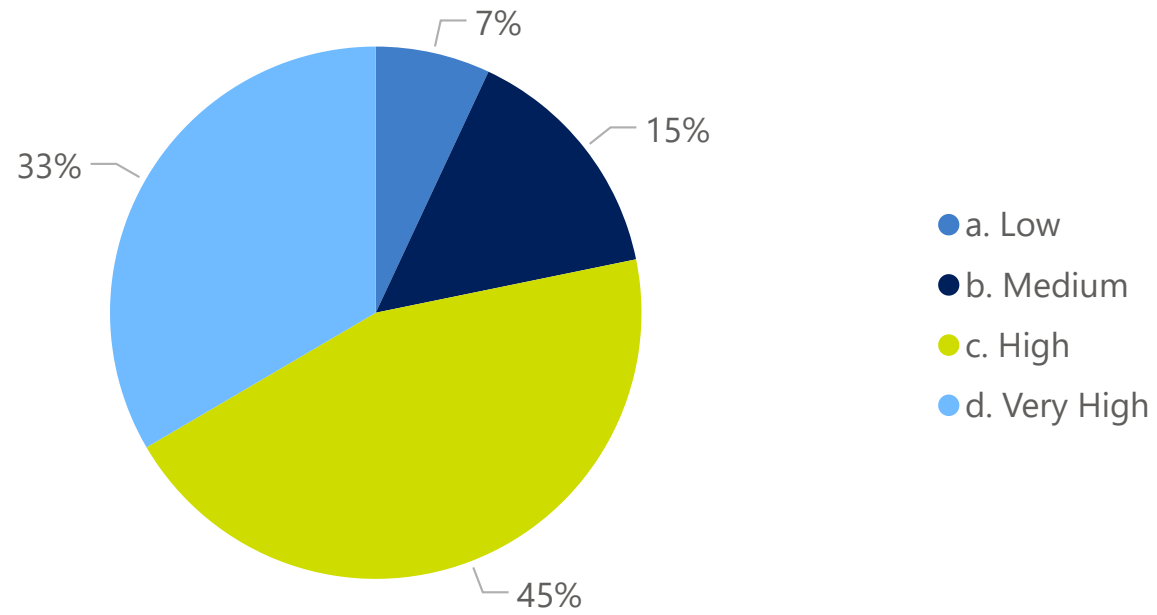

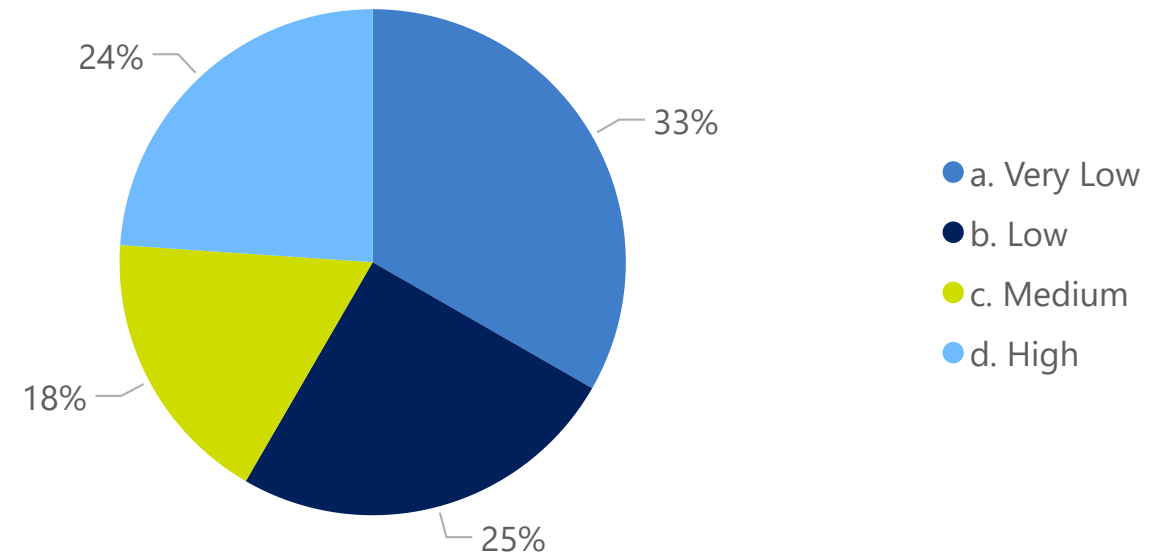

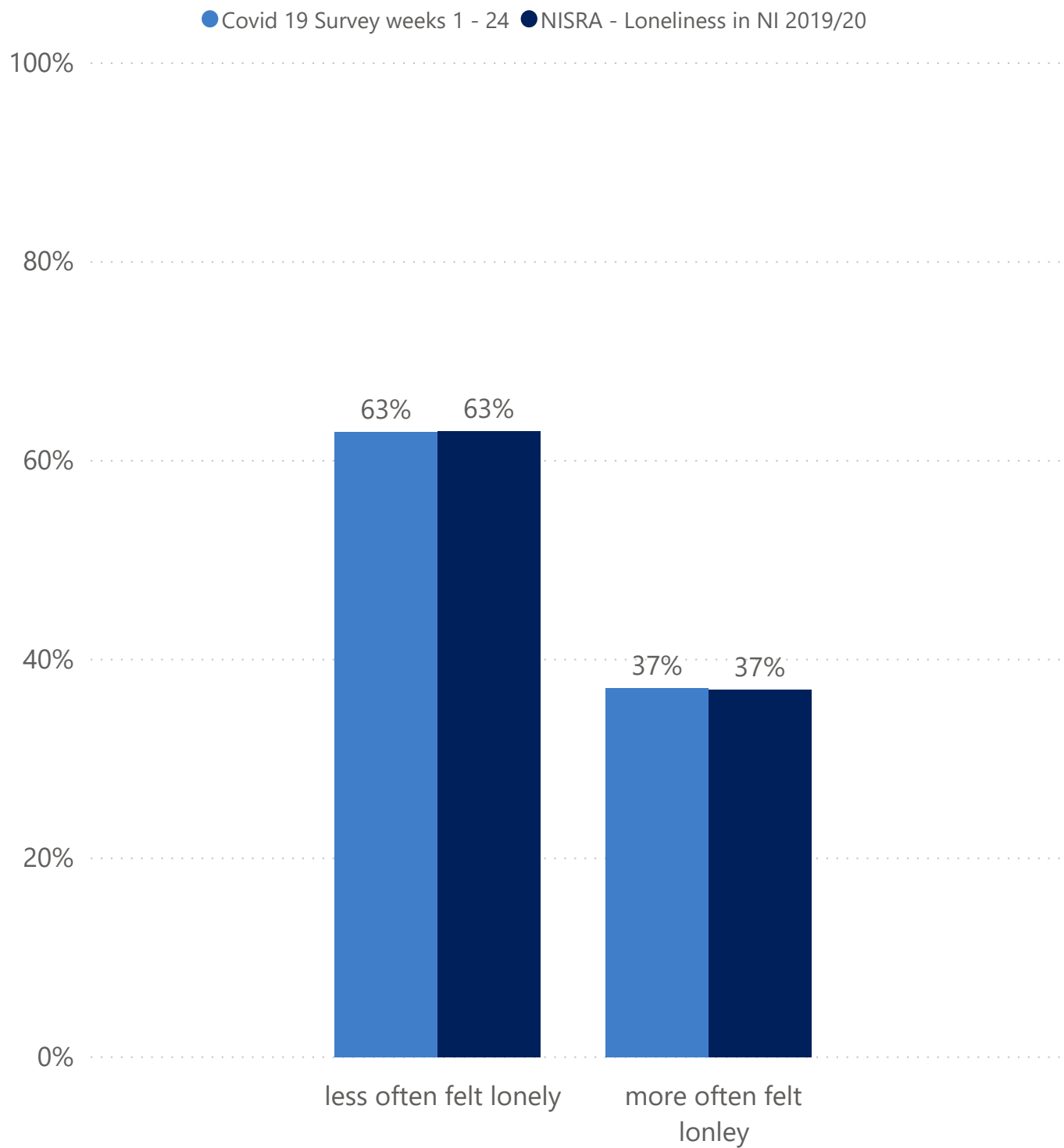

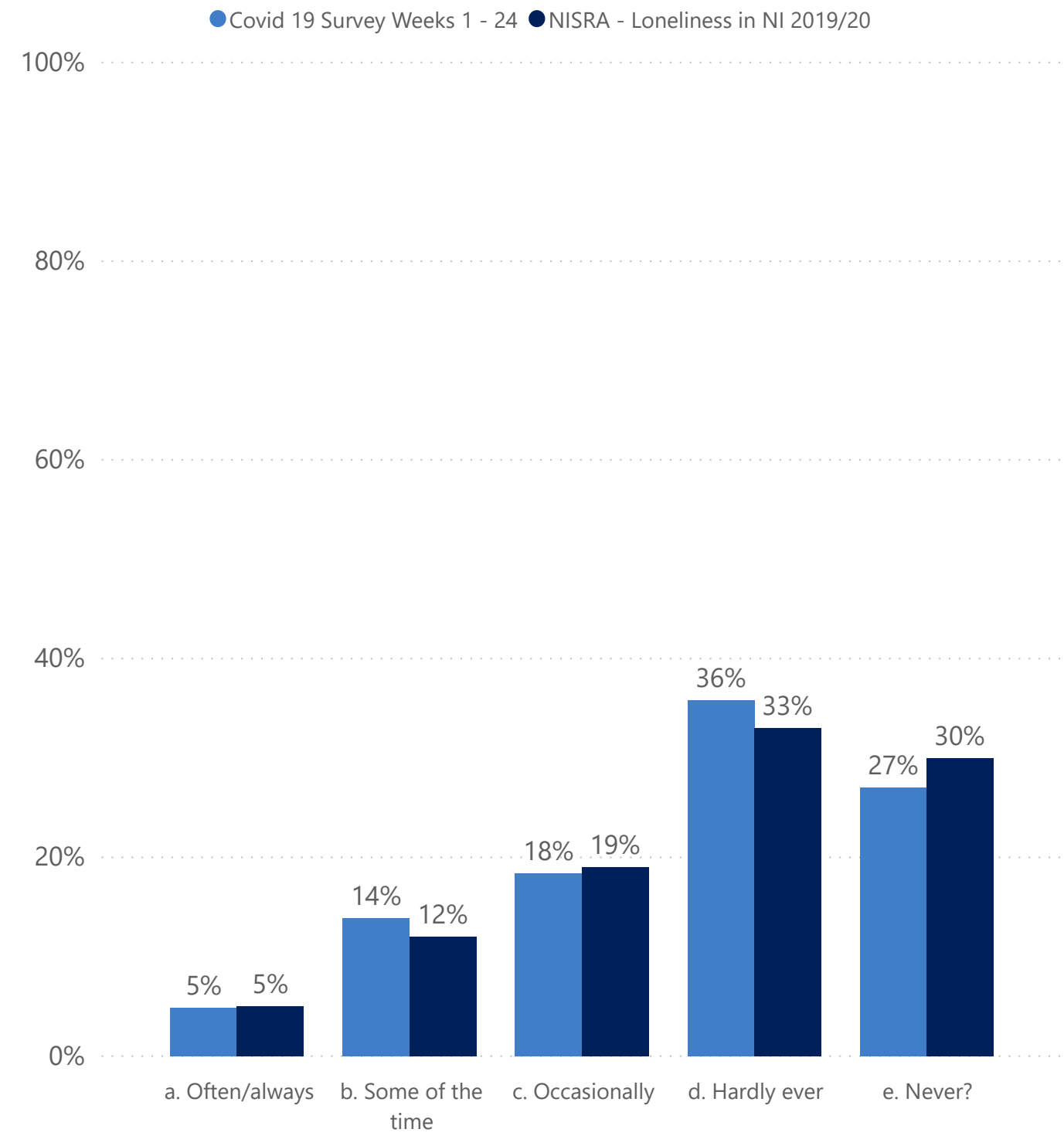

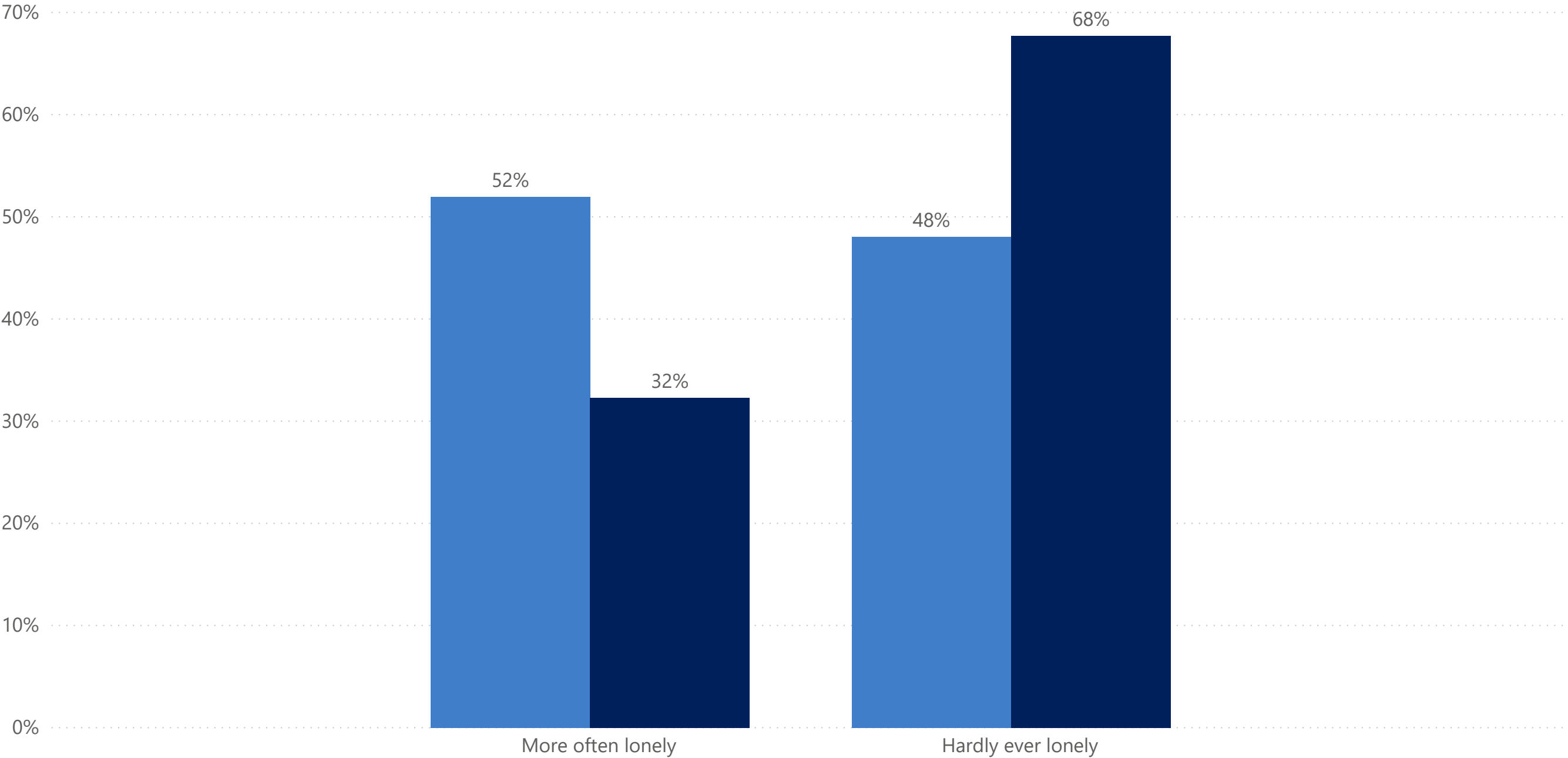

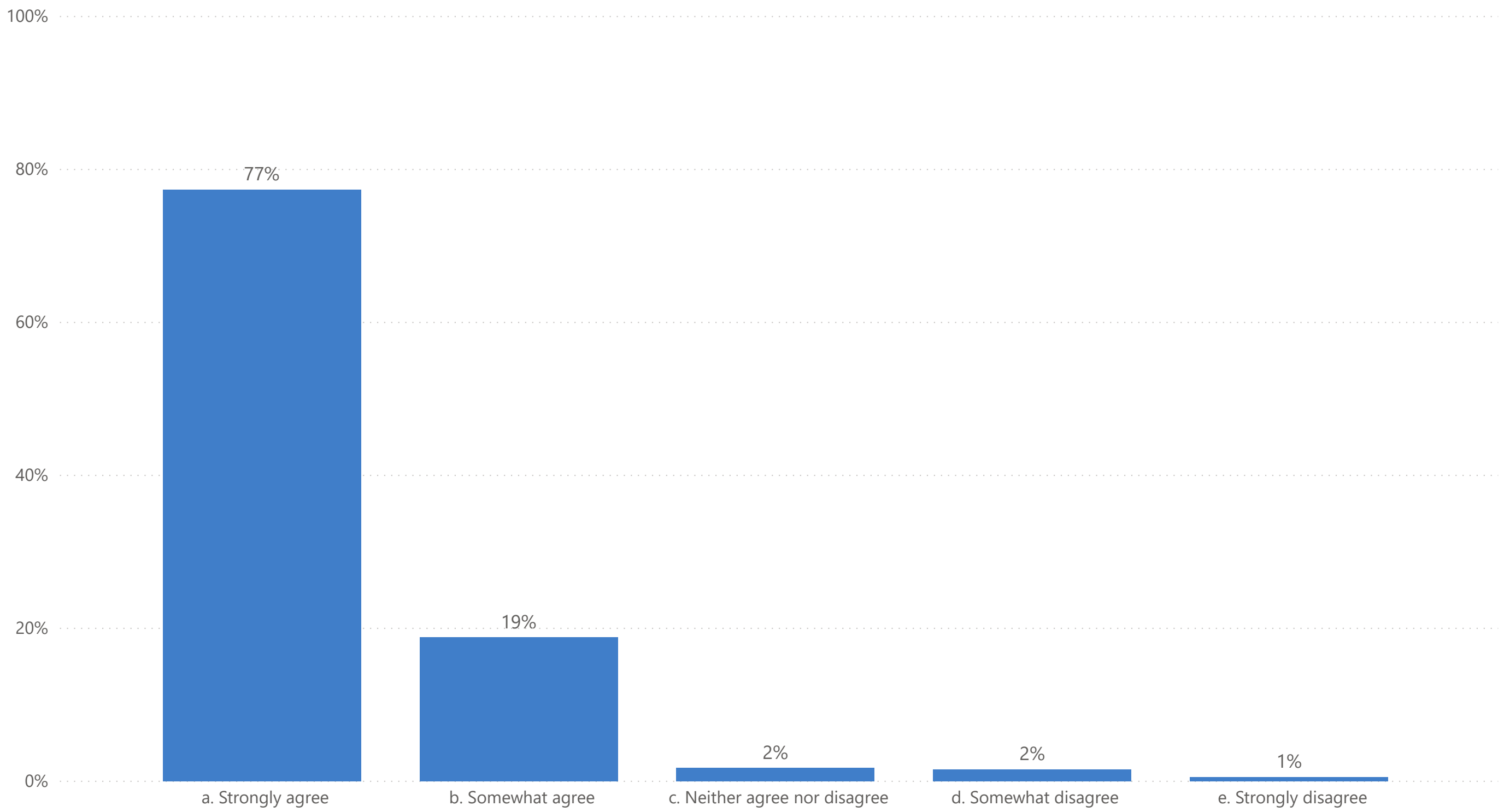

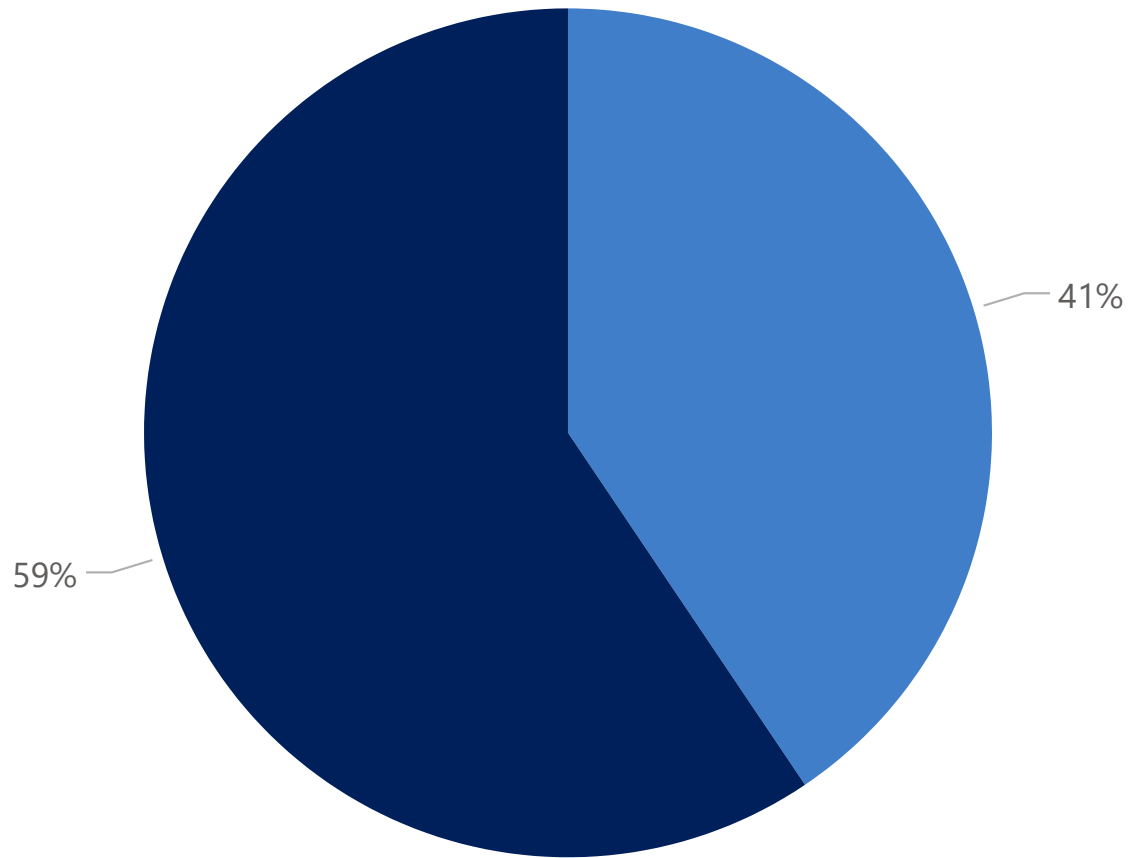

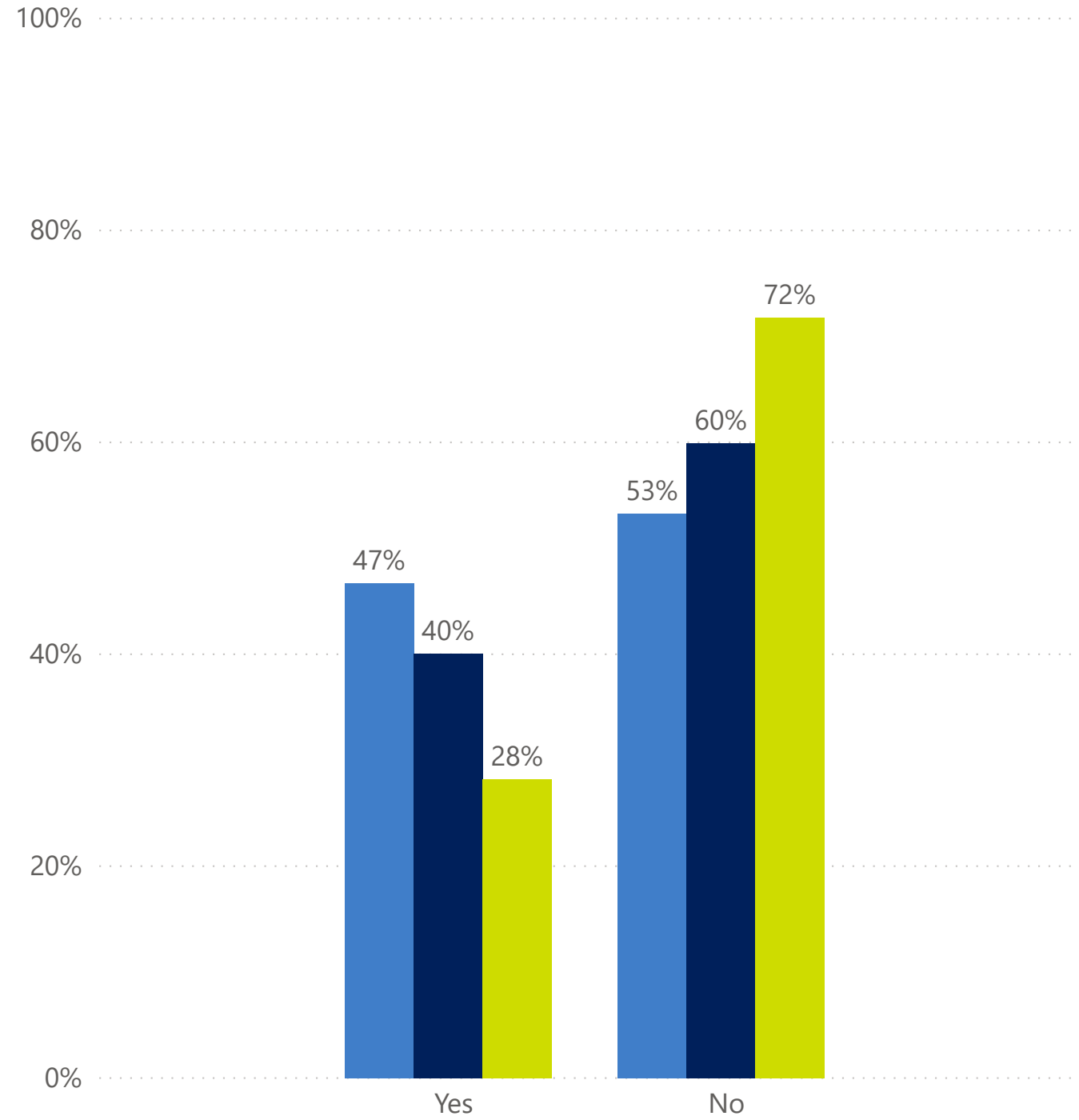

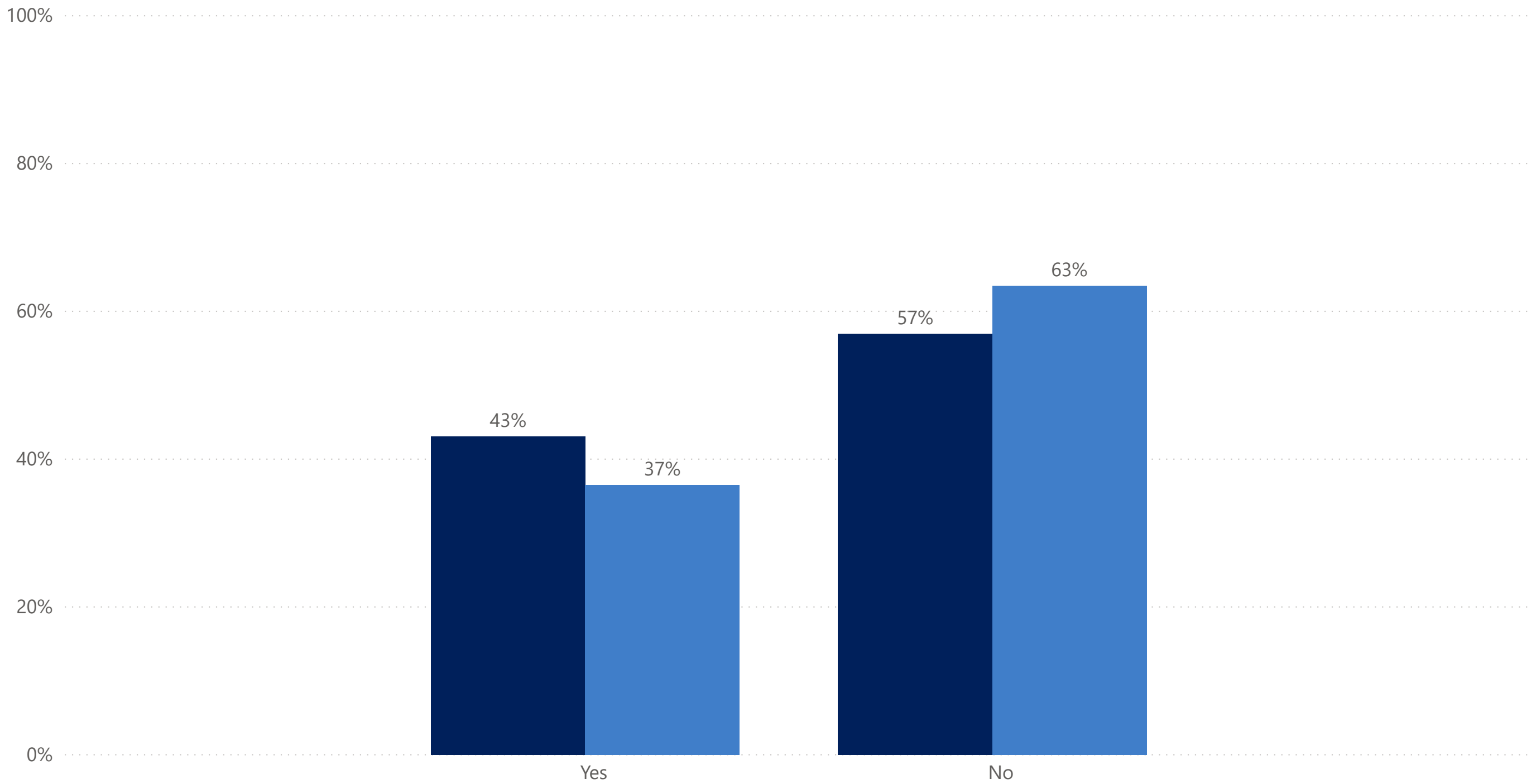

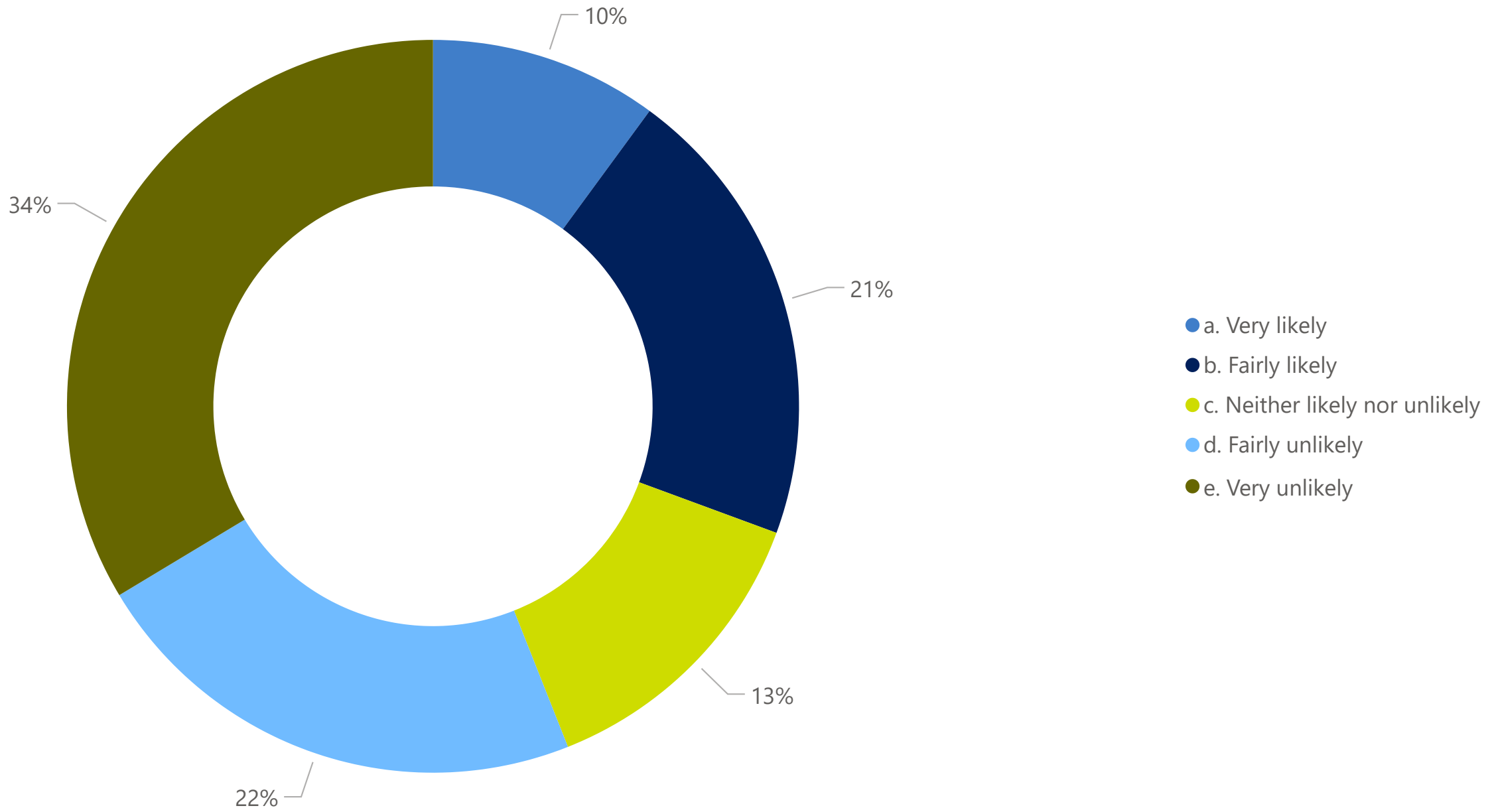

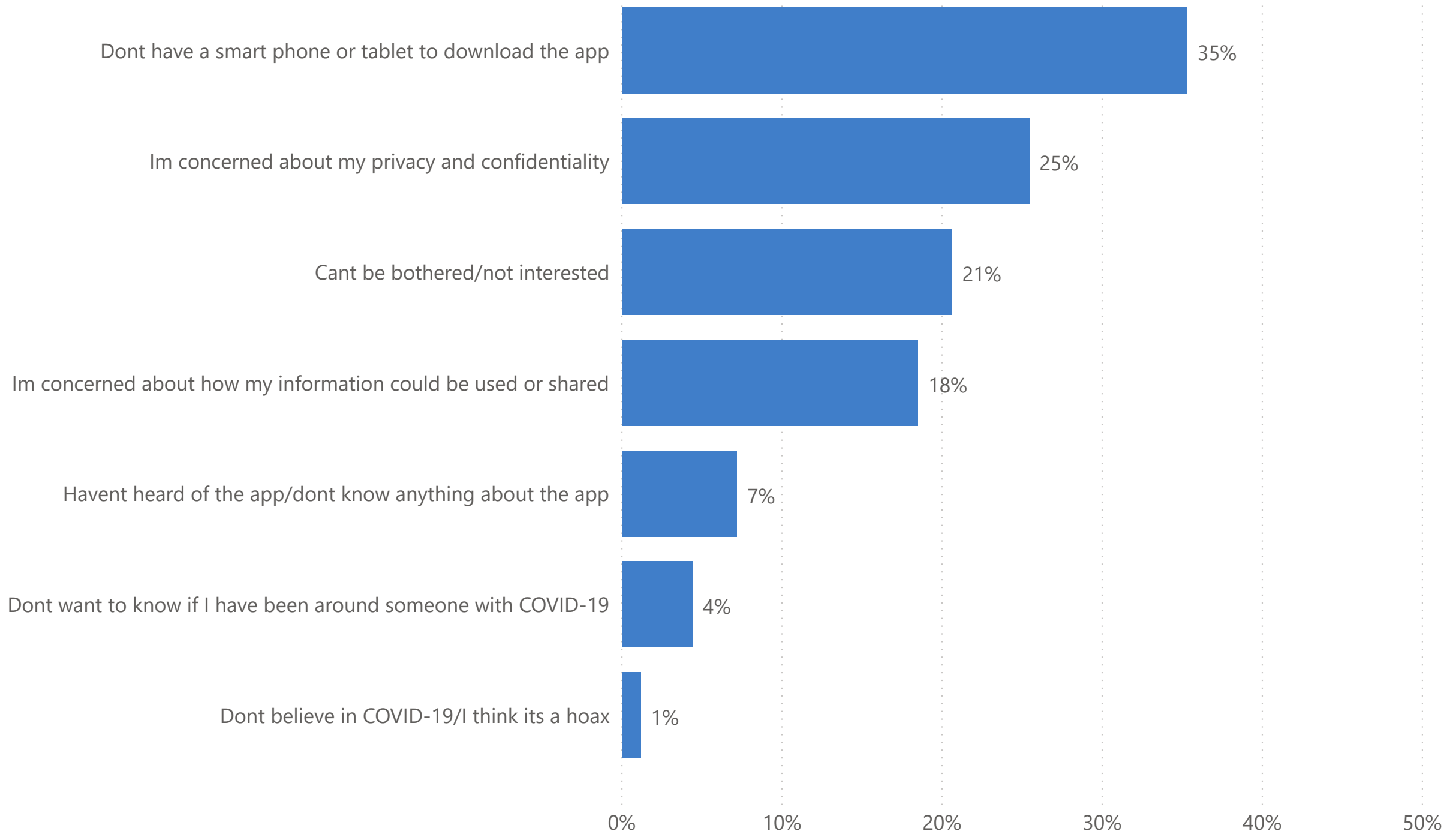

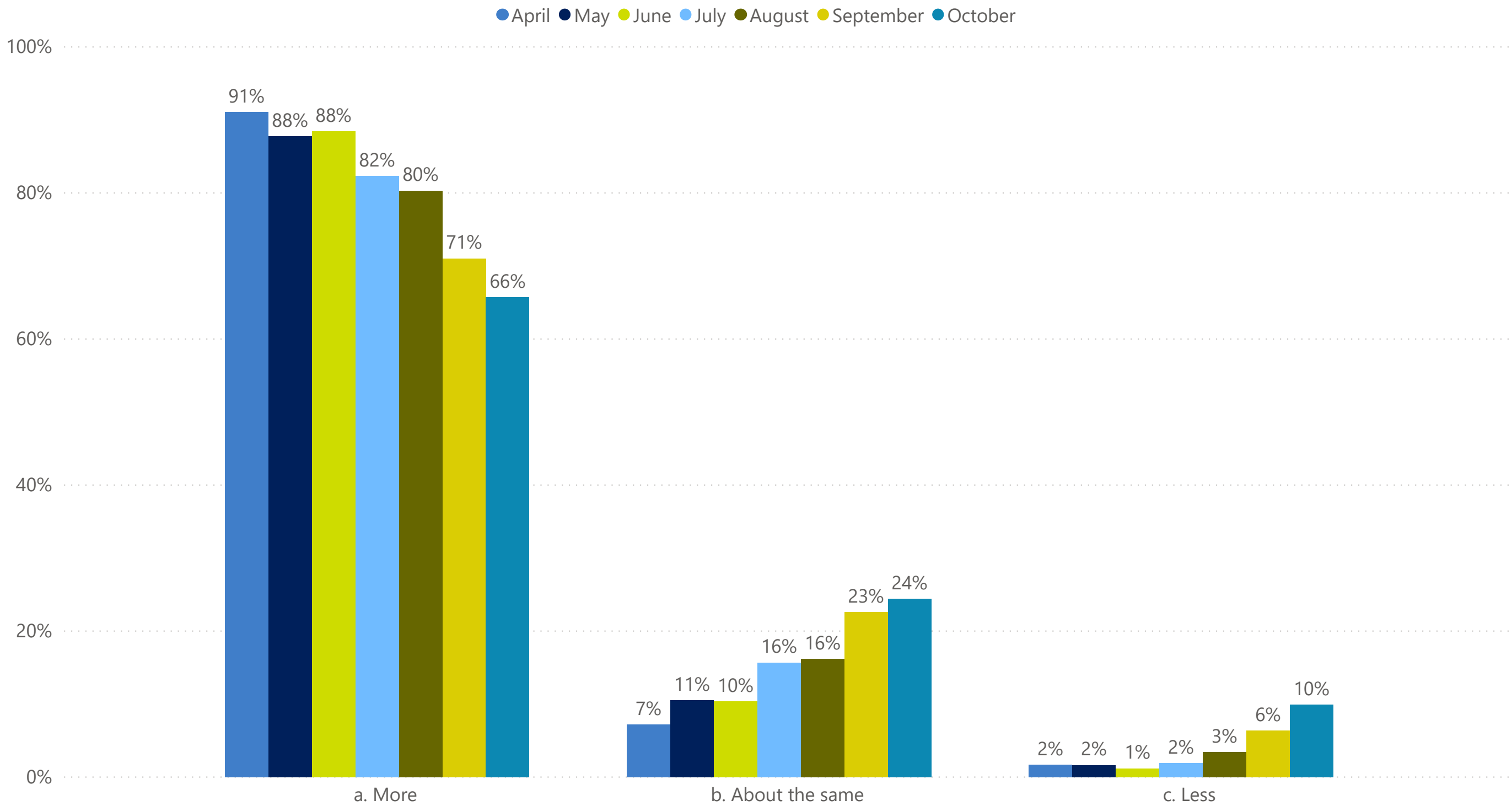

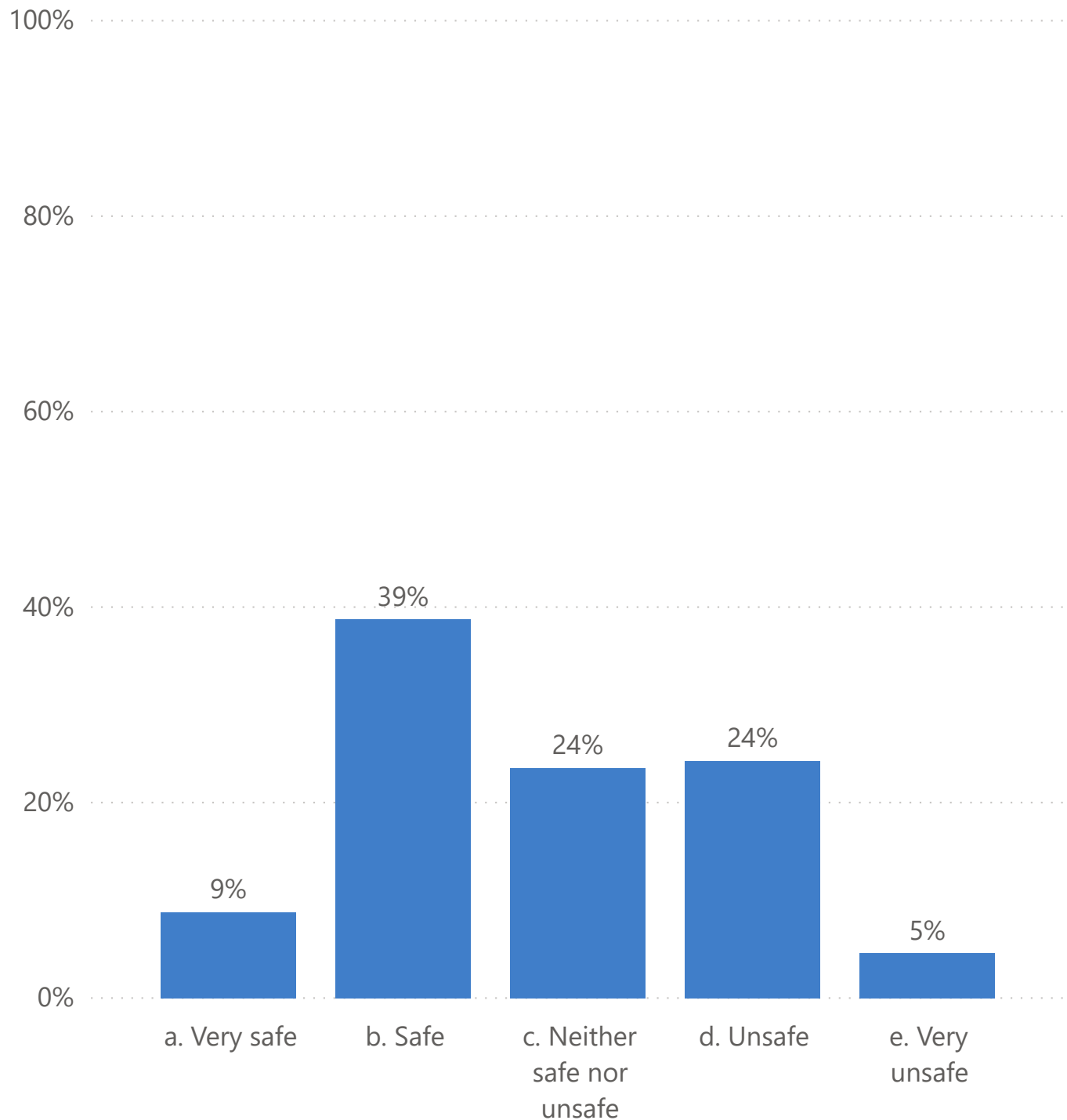

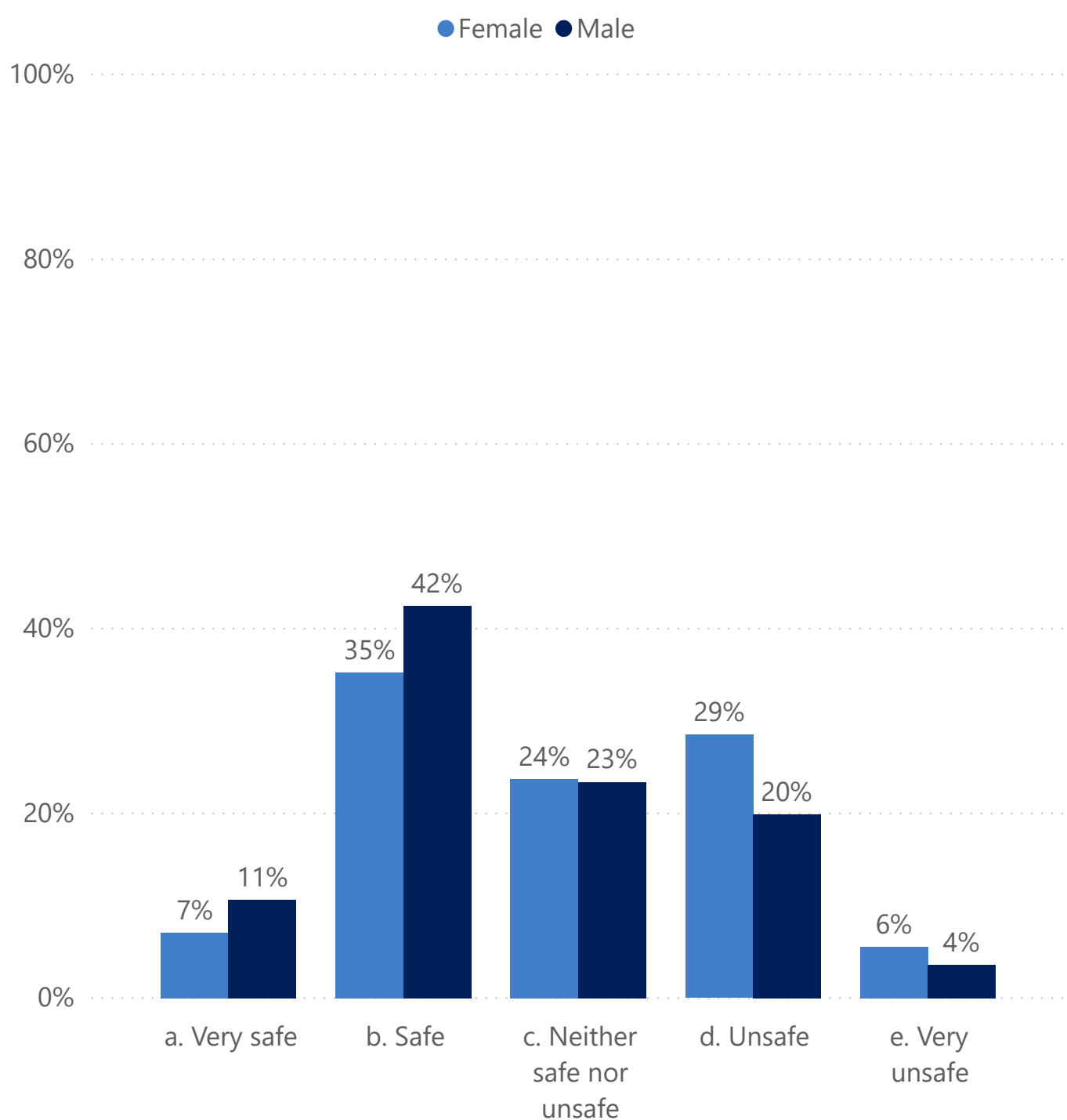

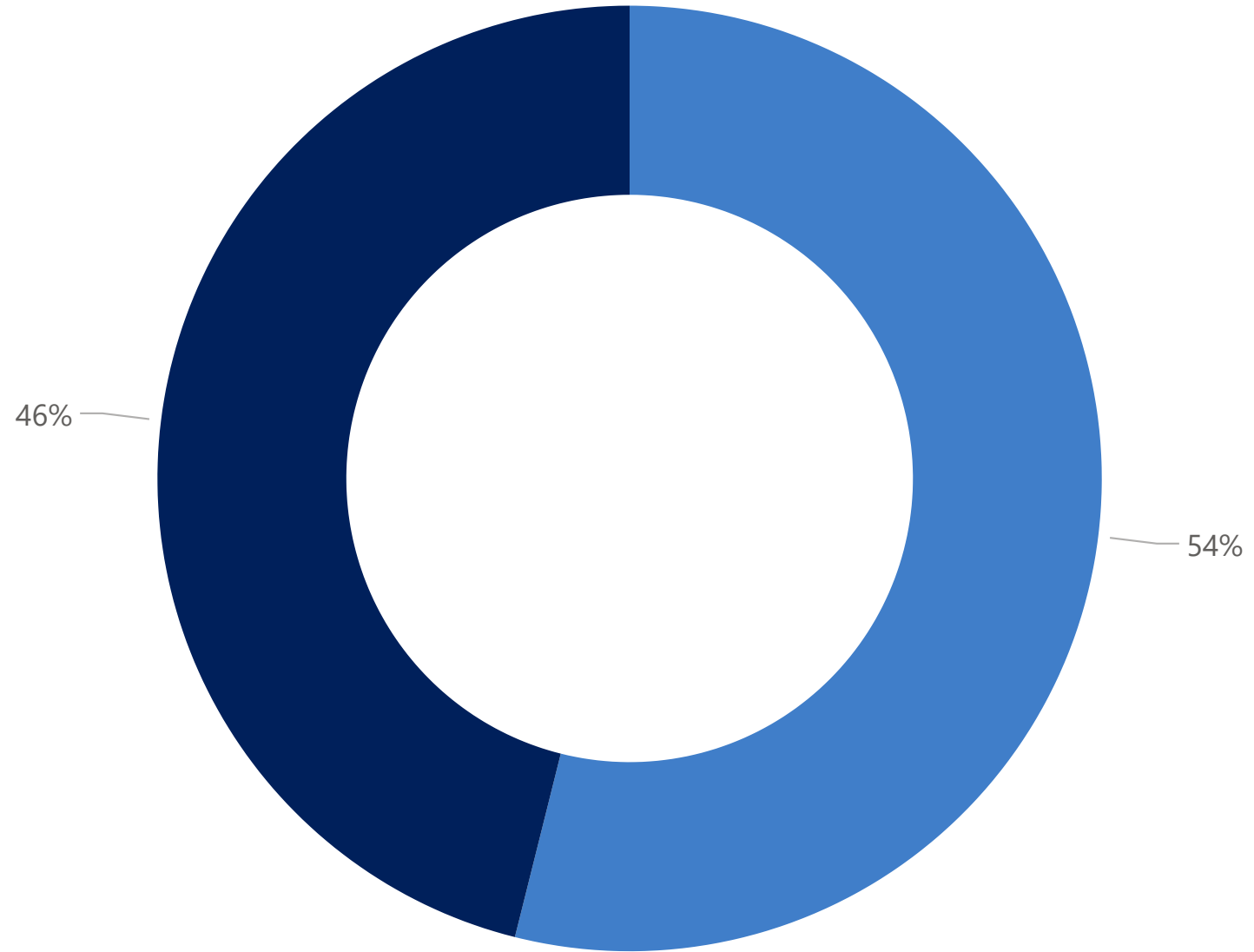


COV_SafUnA: How safe or unsafe do you feel when outside your home due to the coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak?... by sex of respondent

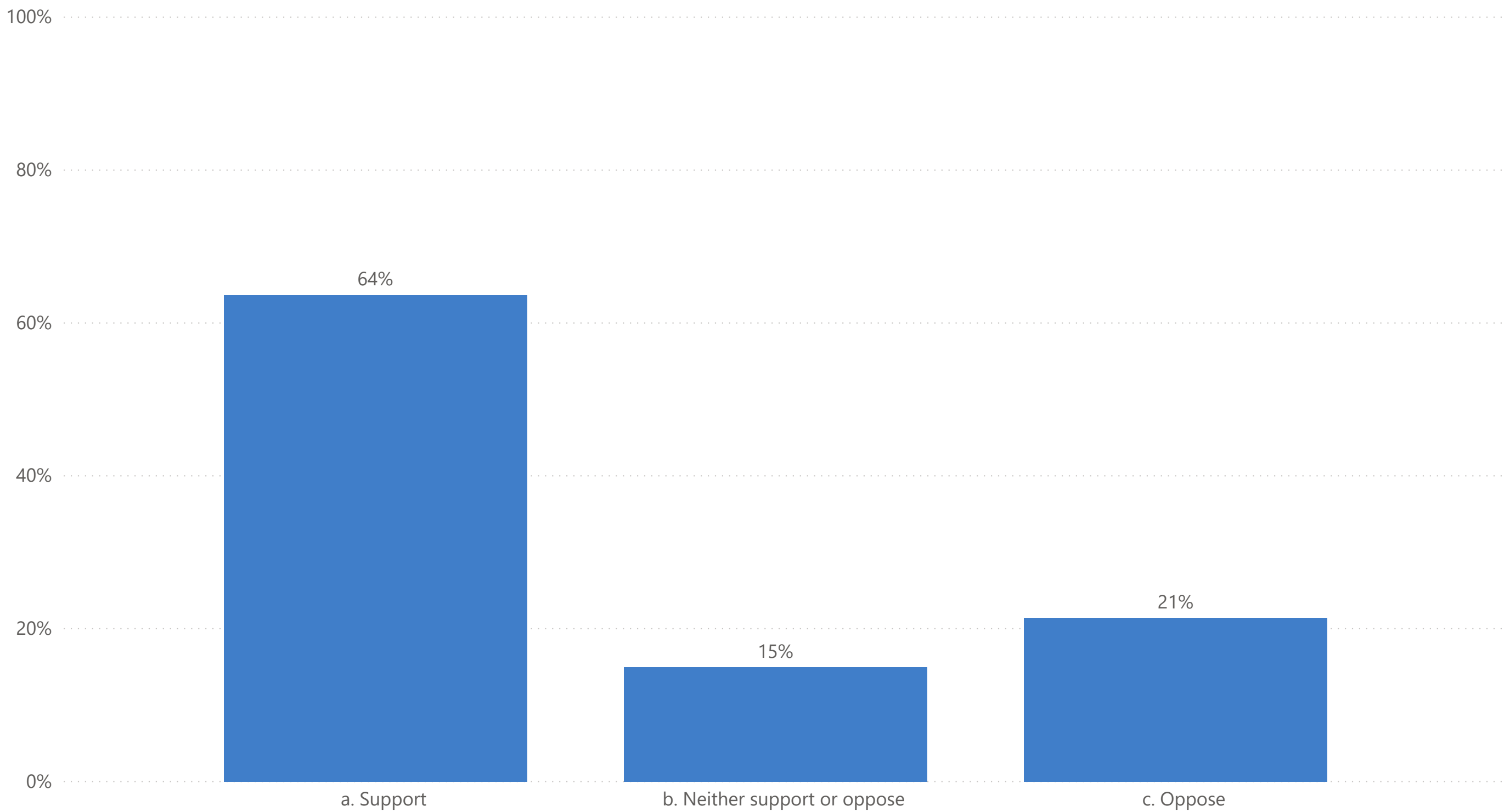

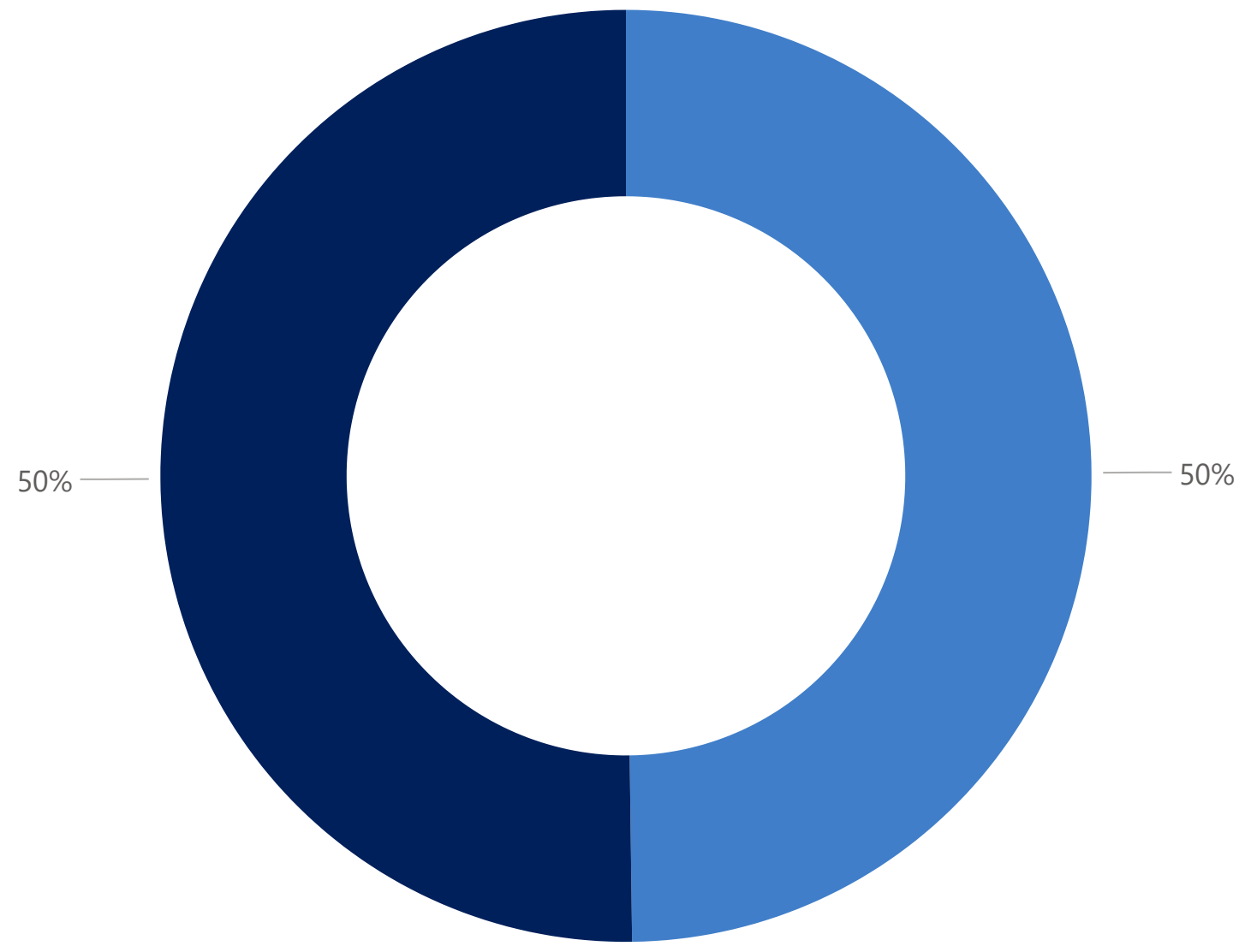


COV_GovM2: To what extent do you support or oppose the easing of stay-at-home measures put in place in the country where you live?... condensed categories

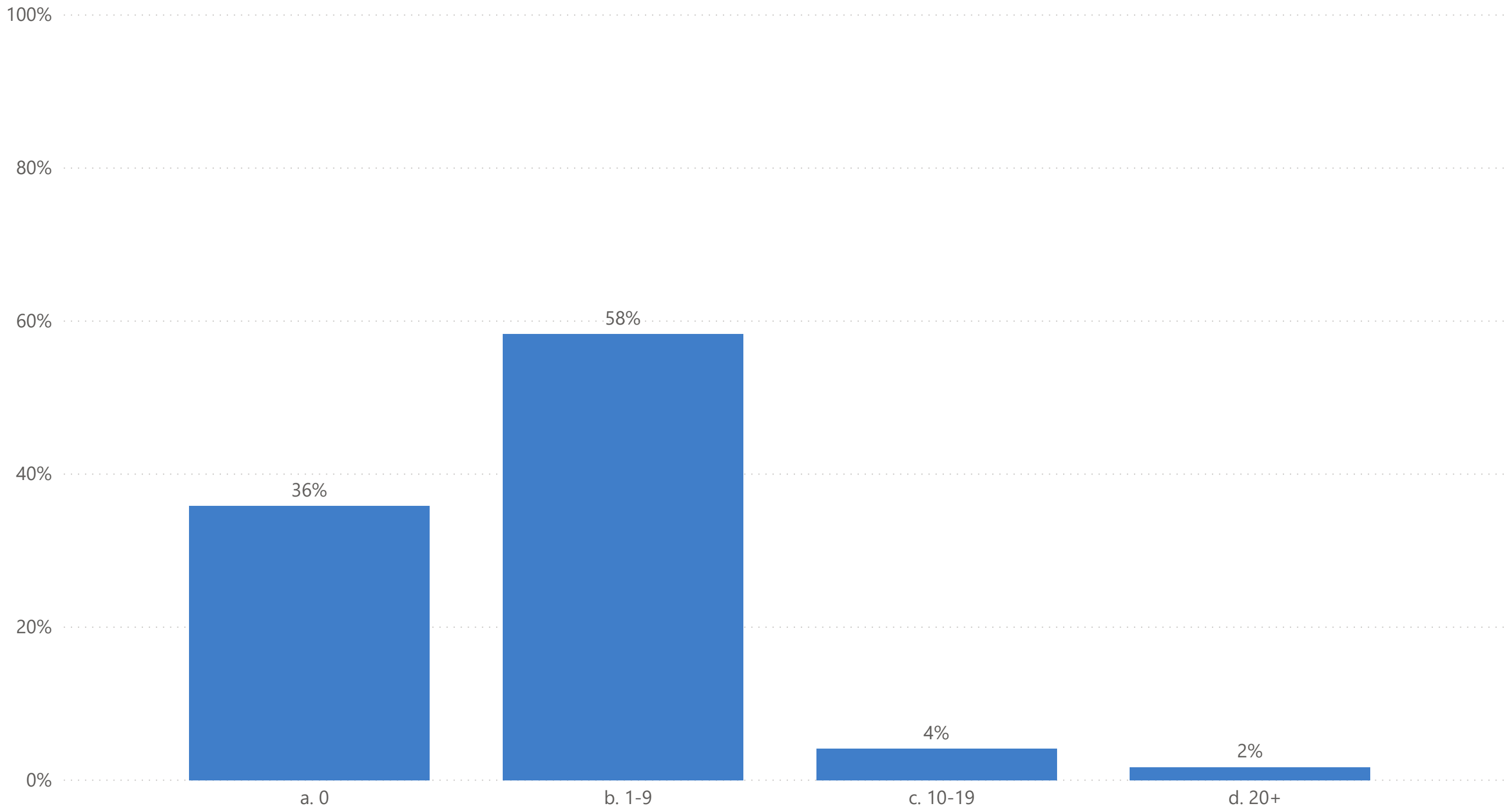


COV_HomVis: In the past seven days, have you had family or friends visit you at your home?

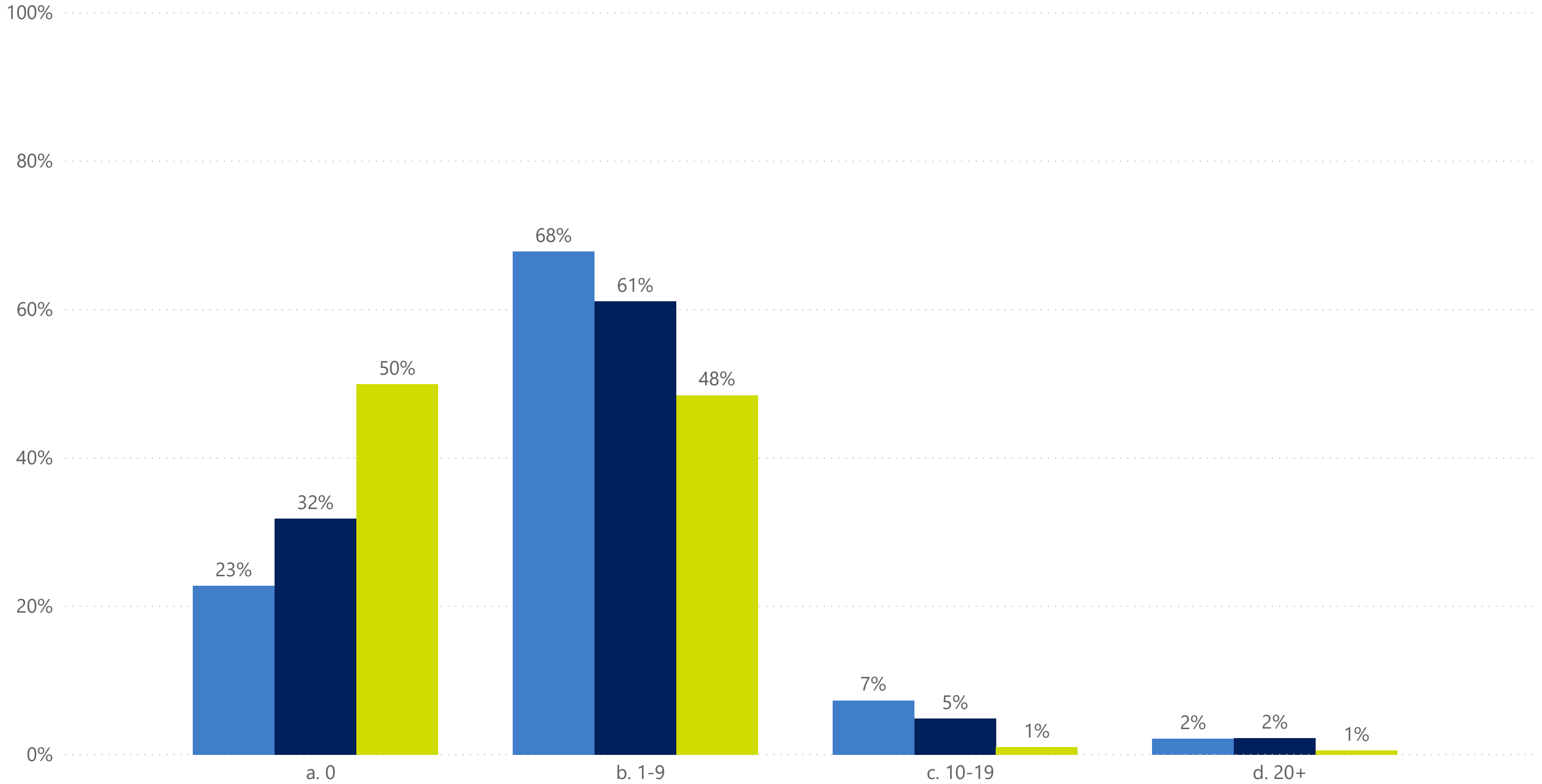


COV_Social: In the past seven days, how many people have you met up with to socialise?

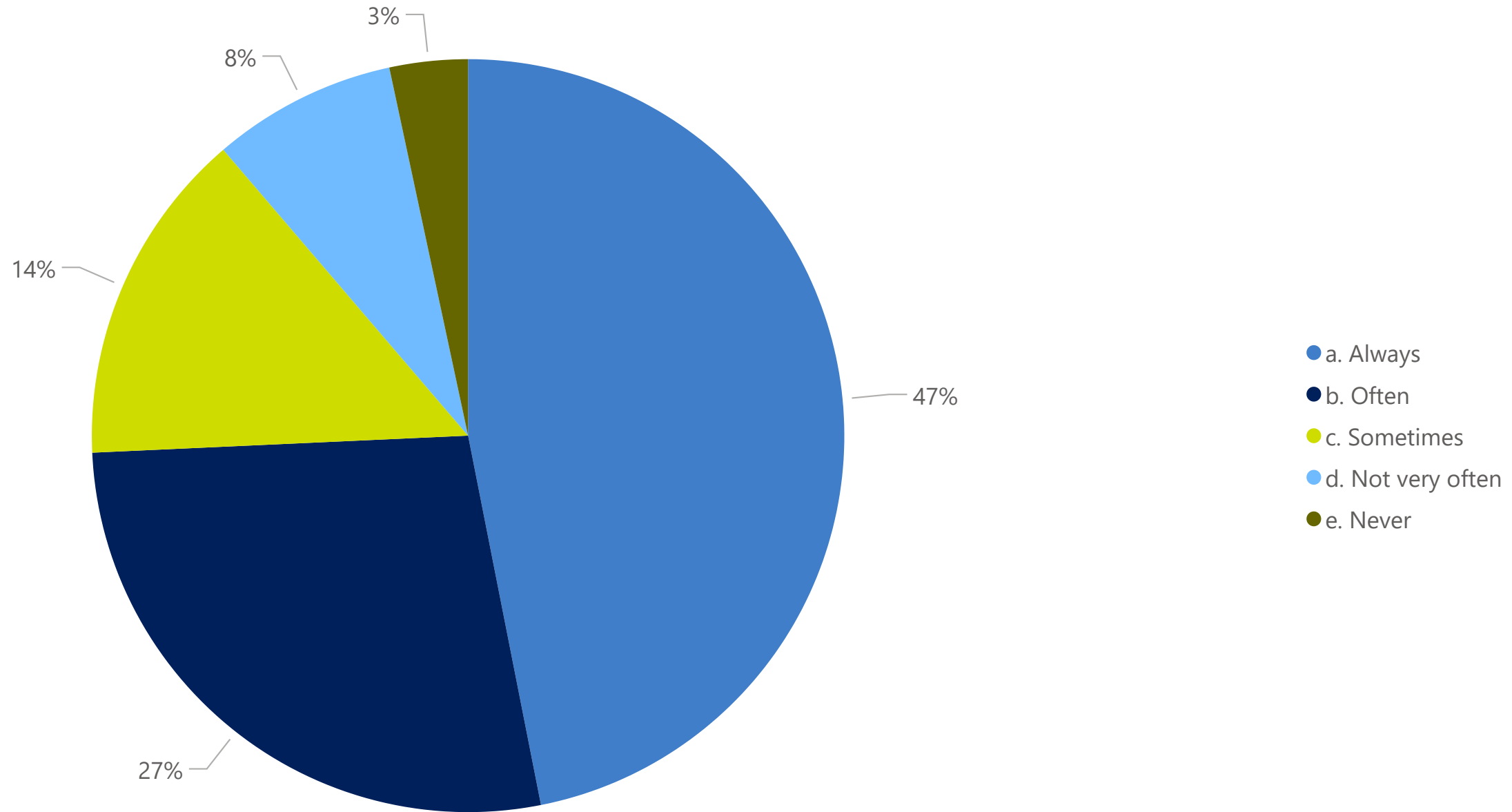


COV_Social: In the past seven days, how many people have you met up with to socialise?... by month of interview

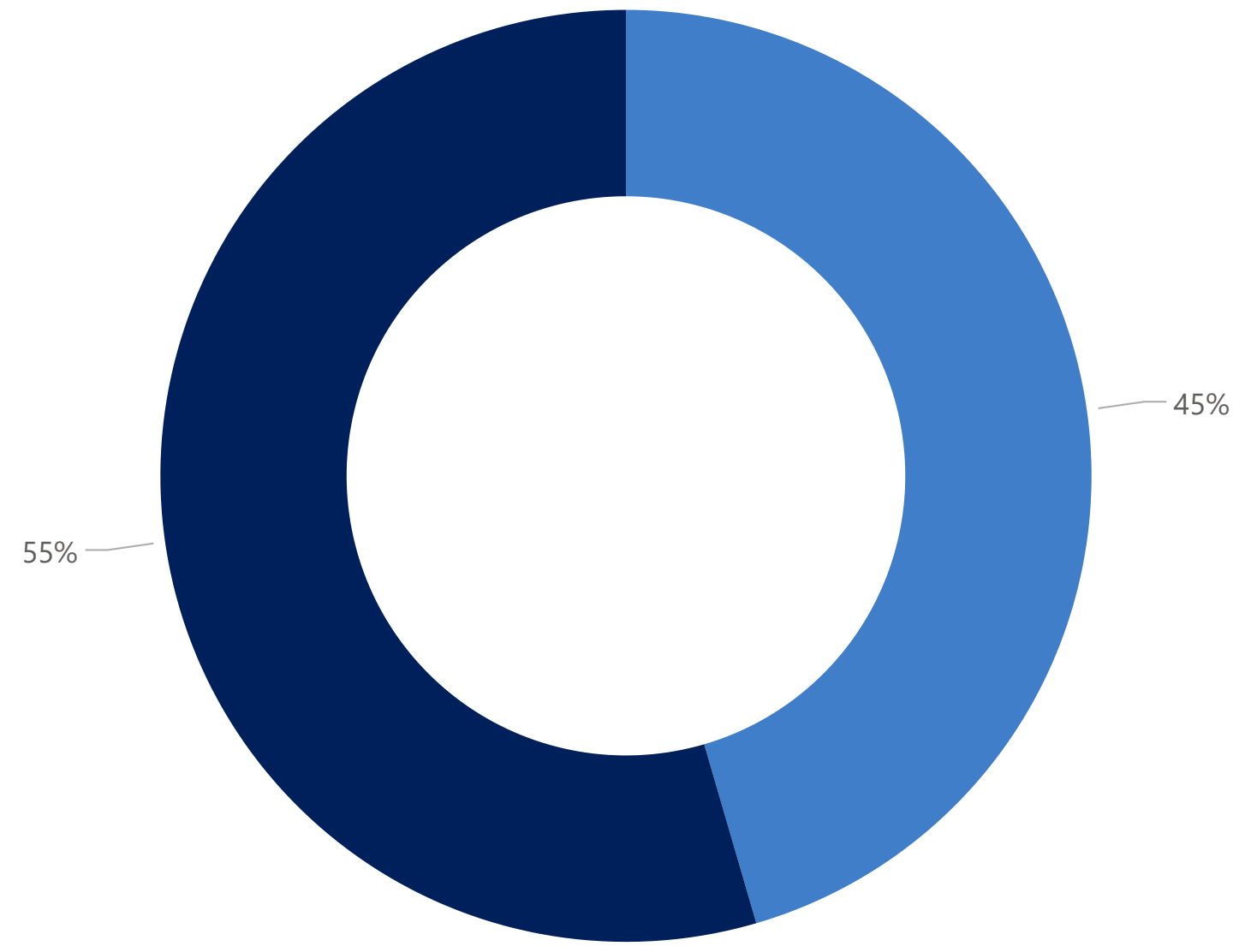


COV_MetDis: In the past seven days, when you have met up with people, how often have you maintained social distancing?... asked if COV_Social is greater than zero OR don't know

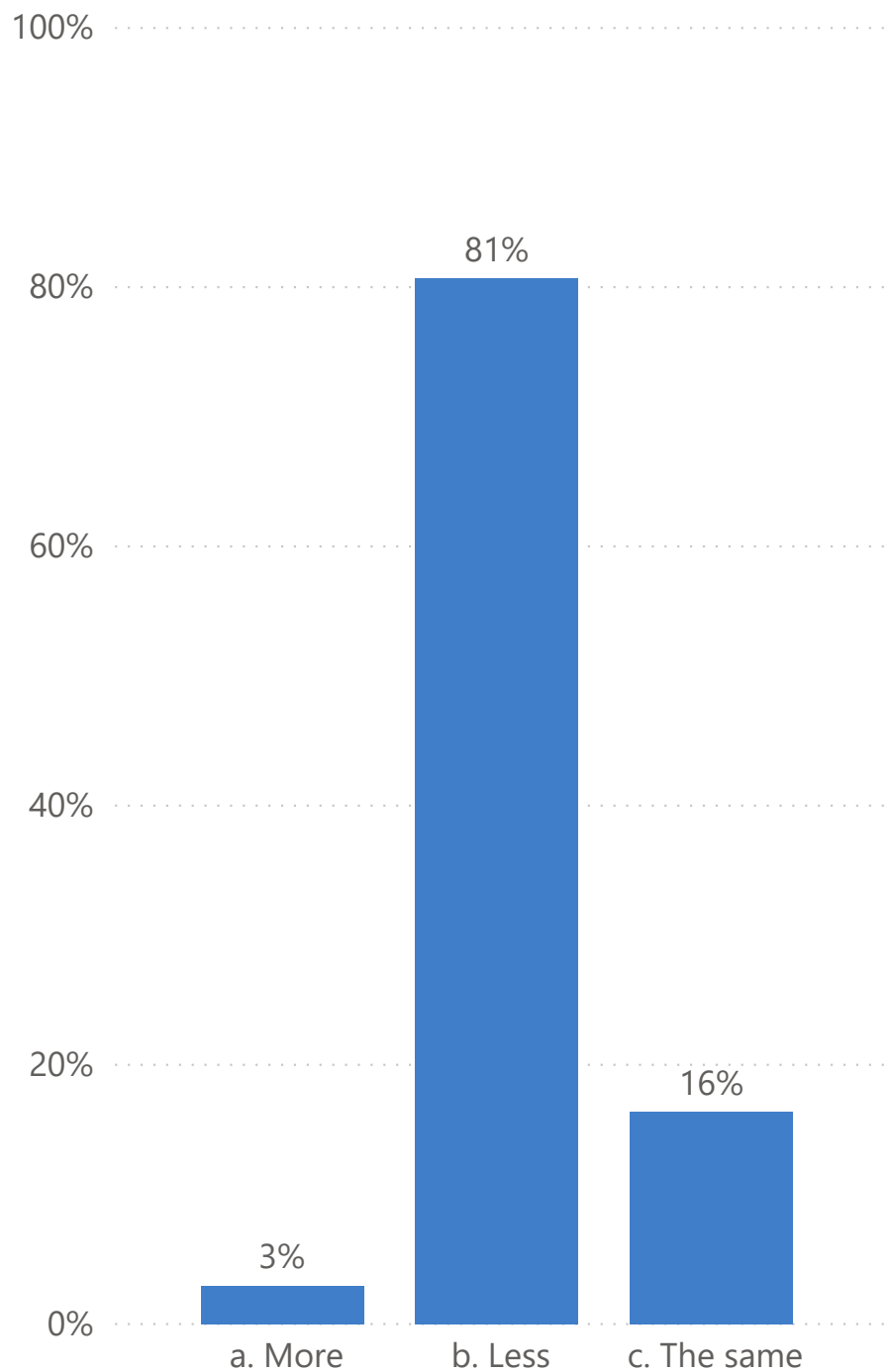

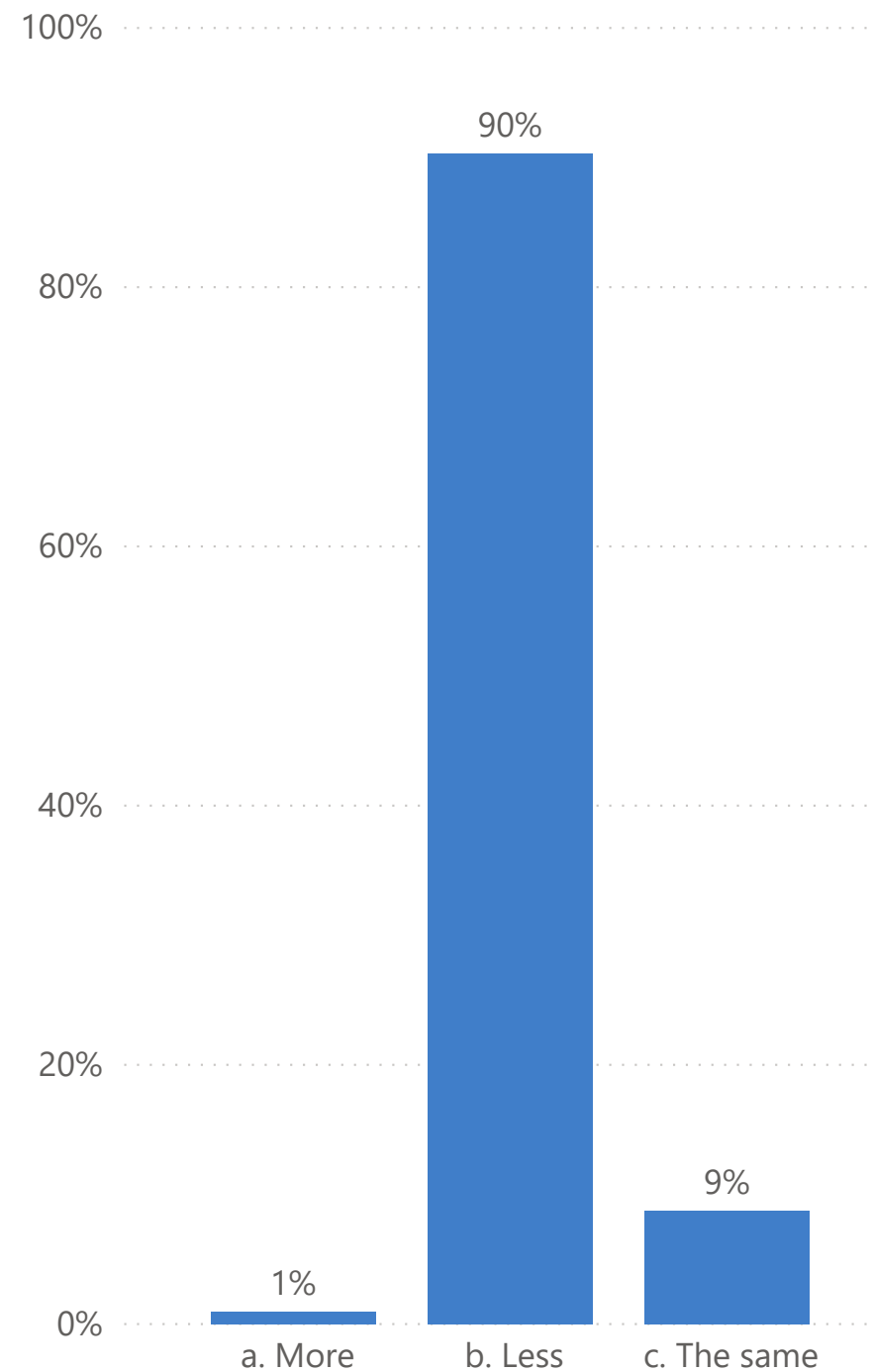

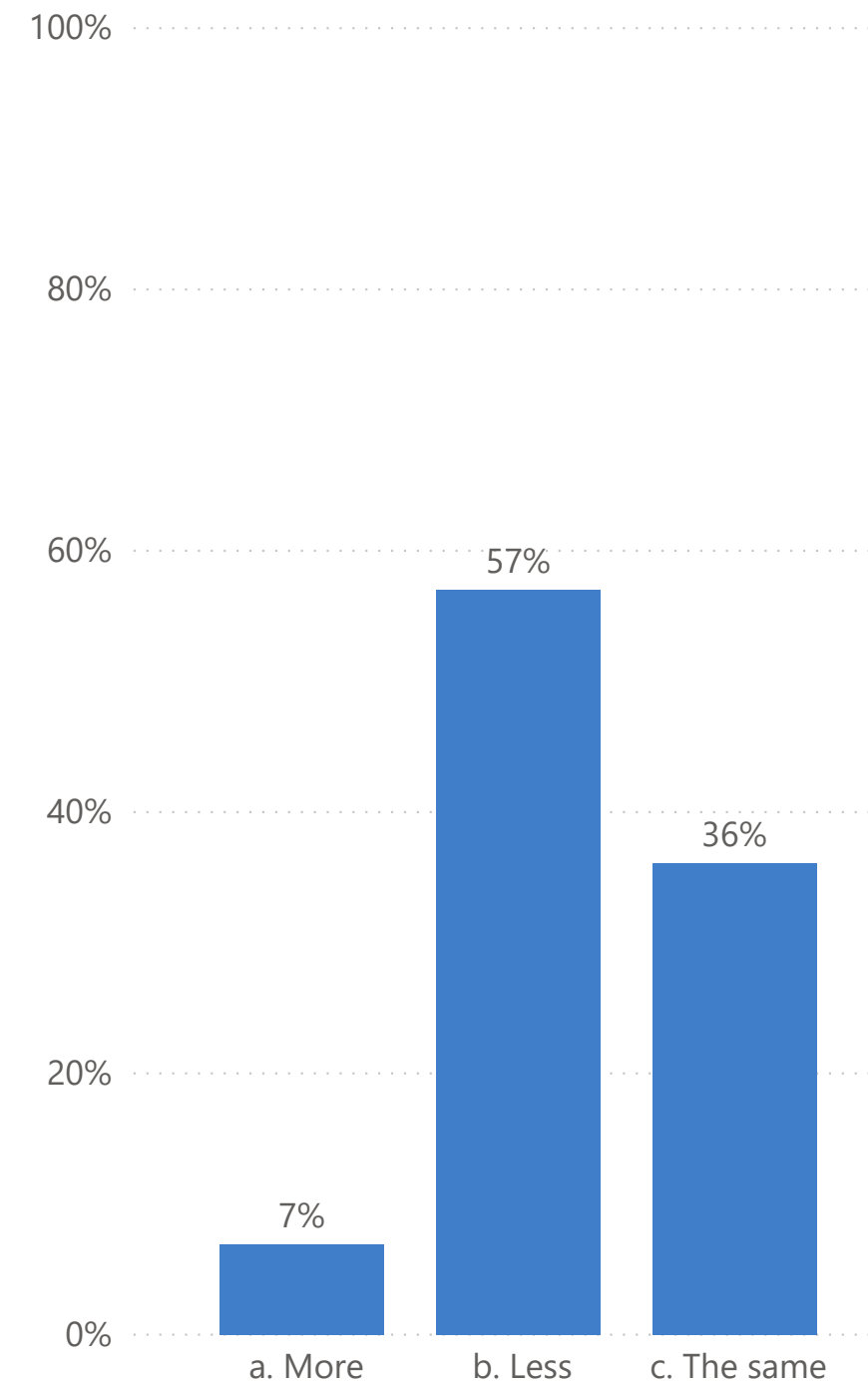

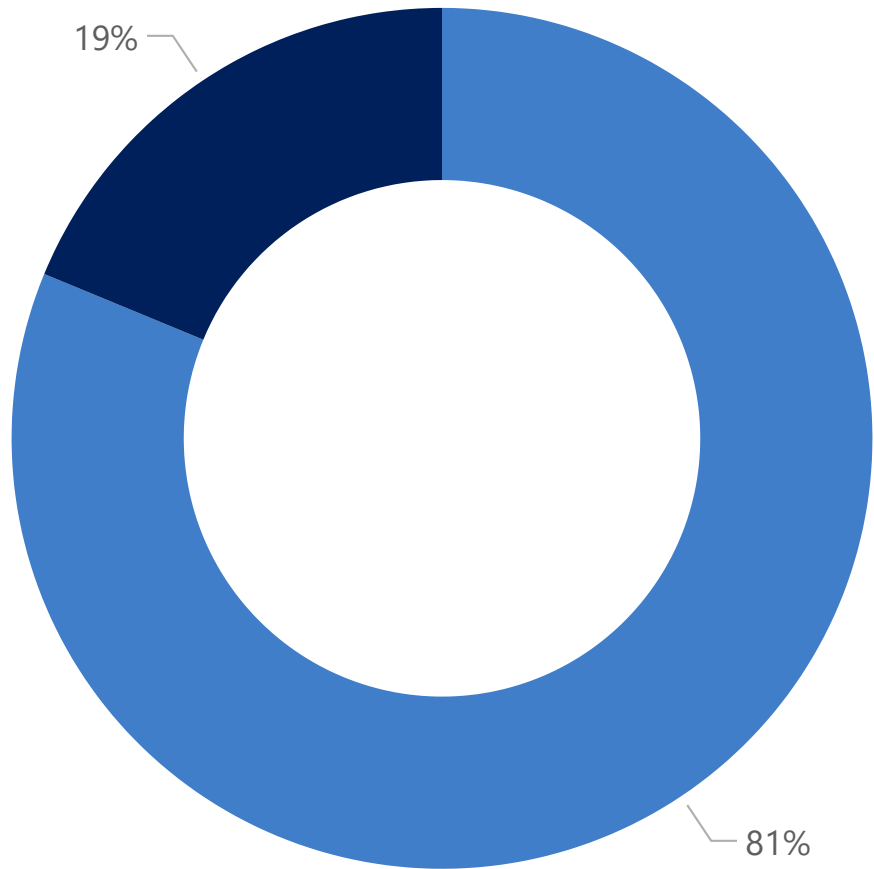

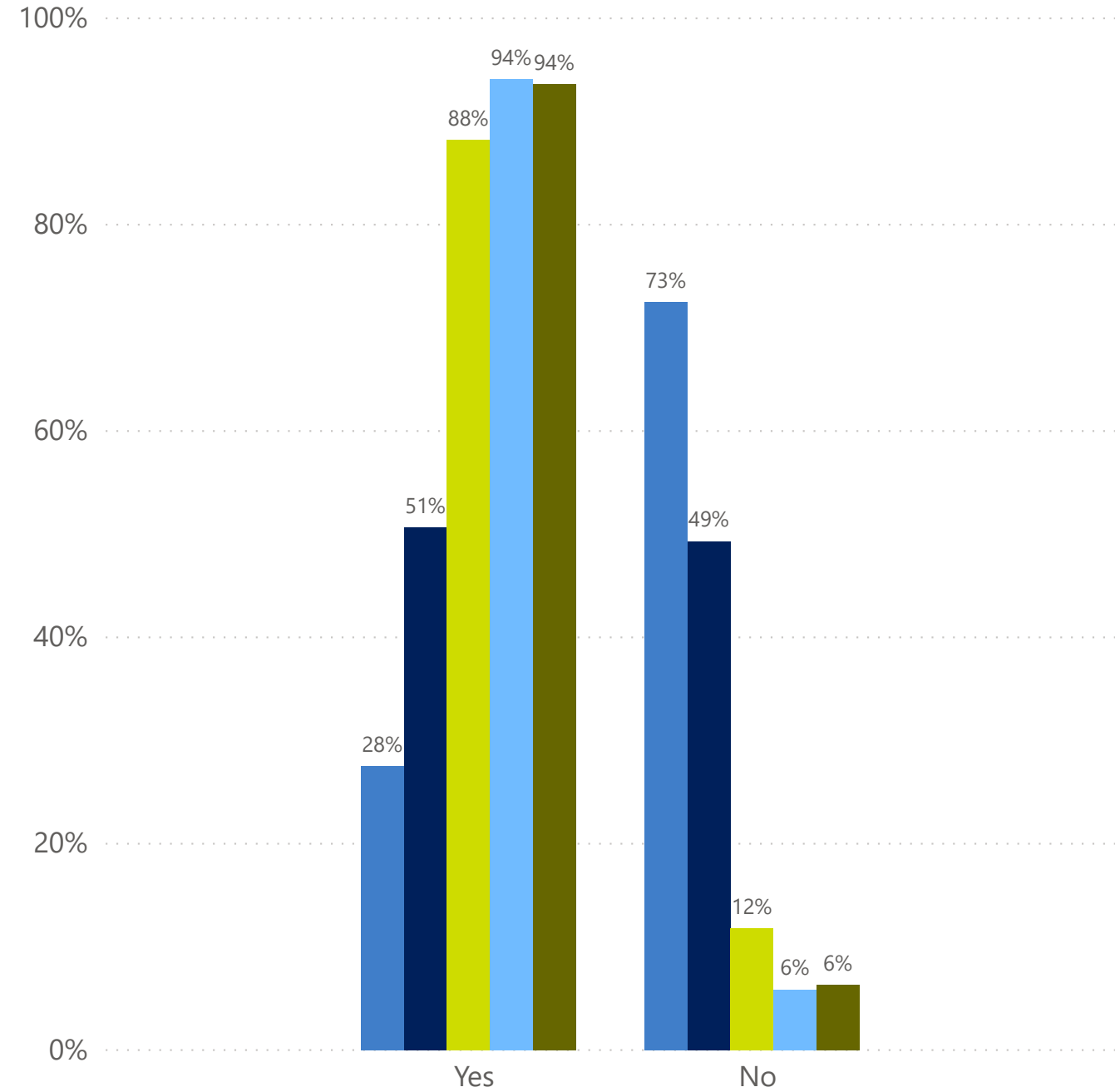

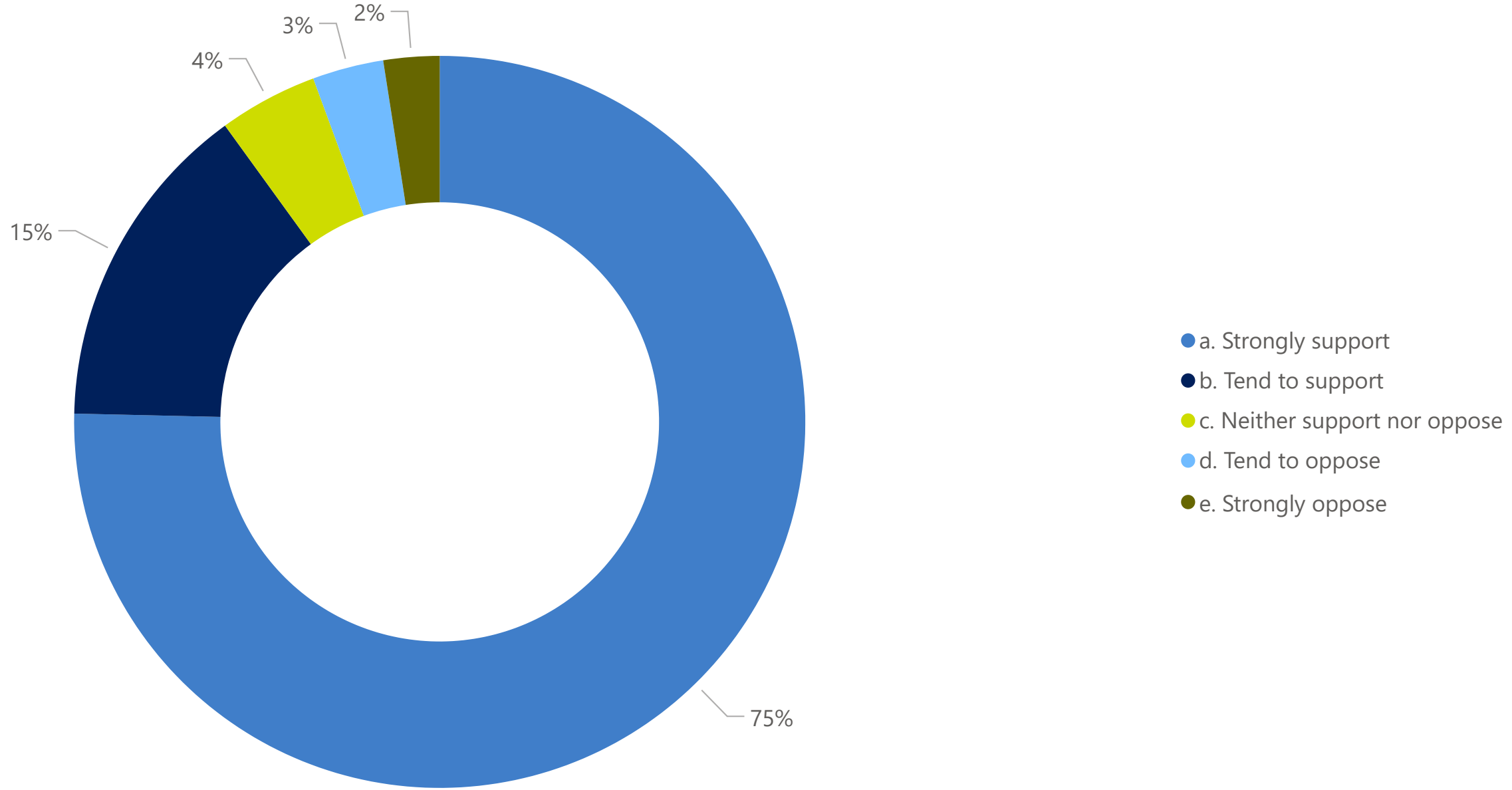

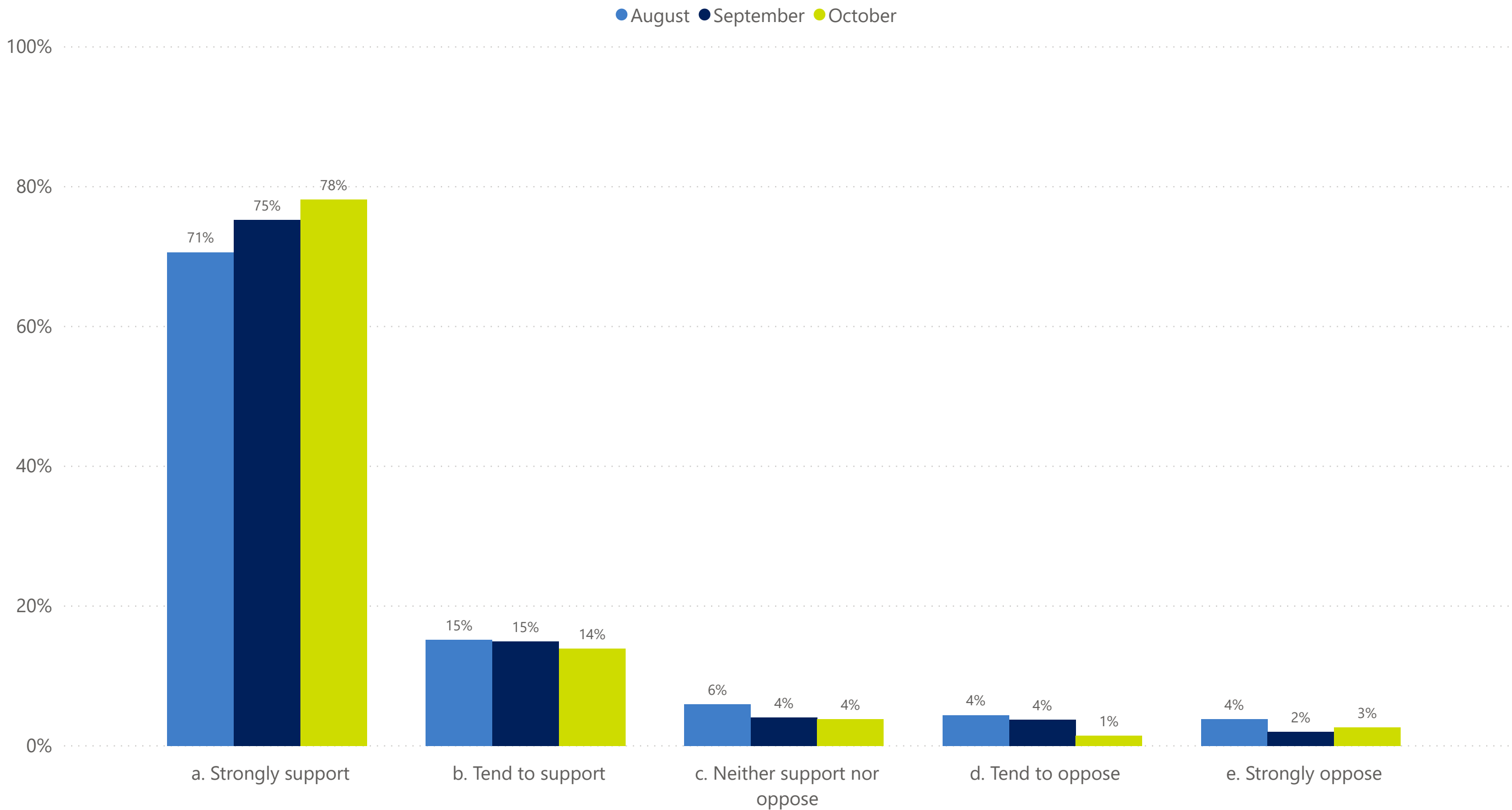
