User note...


- 1. A purchase by a Northern Ireland business from a Great Britain business does not necessarily equate to a full market transaction. For example, some purchases will relate to a large GB company transferring goods from a distribution centre in GB to a branch located within NI.
- 2. It should be noted that GB might not be the origin of the product but is where businesses have reported they have it purchased it from.
- 3. The goods figures shown here exclude sales of live animals. The services figures will also exclude transactions relating to tourism and financial services.
- 4. Figures shown here are based primarily on the <u>Broad Economy Sales and Exports</u> <u>Statistics (BESES)</u>, therefore they are survey based estimates.




Total value of NI external sales by destination 2011 to 2017 (£bn)



Northern Ireland (NI) businesses made significant use of goods & services purchased from Great Britain (GB) businesses in 2017





65% of goods purchased by NI businesses from GB businesses were aimed at the NI Wholesale and Retail Sector in 2017






Purchases of goods from GB by NI businesses* (by value(£) 2017)





NI industries* most dependent on purchases of goods from GB businesses (more than 30% of all purchases), 2017






Total value of NI purchases of goods and value of goods purchased from GB by business size, 2017 (£bn)

 34% of the value of all purchases of goods by NI large businesses are from GB businesses






Total value of NI sales of goods and value of goods sold to GB by business size, 2017 (£bn)


 10% of the value of all sales by NI microbusinesses are to GB businesses

Irish Sea (IE/NI←→GB) 1.8 million HGV crossings 2018



An estimated 1.8 million Irish Sea (IE/NI ← GB) HGV crossings in 2018. Of these:

- 0.9* million (47%) were between NI and GB
- 1.0* million (53%) were between Ireland (IE) and GB

There were a further 182,000 air traffic movements between airports in NI/IE and GB; and 32,000 vessel arrivals at NI and IE sea ports (including GB and other international arrivals).



Irish Sea (IE/NI↔GB) 38 million tonnes of sea freight in 2018




An estimated 38 million tonnes of sea freight crossing the Irish Sea ($IE/NI \leftrightarrow GB$) in 2018. Of these:

- 19 million tonnes (49%) were between NI and GB
 - NI received 9.8 million tonnes (52%)
 - NI forwarded 9.0 million tonnes (48%)
- 19 million tonnes (51%) were between IE and GB
 - IE received 11.2 million tonnes (57%)
 - IE forwarded 8.3 million tonnes (43%)

Irish Sea (IE/NI←→GB) 52,300 tonnes of air freight in 2018



An estimated 52,300 tonnes of air freight crossing the Irish Sea (IE/NI \leftrightarrow GB) in 2018. Of these:

- 16,700 tonnes (32%) were between NI and GB
- 35,600 tonnes (68%) were between IE and GB

Transportation of goods NI ↔ GB

- Macro-economic data suggests that most of the movement of goods to/from GB which directly involves a NI business is through a NI air or sea port
- The latest estimates from DAERA are that around 75% of the value of goods sold in to GB by NI food and drinks businesses is transported through an NI air or sea port
- That said intelligence suggests that the delivery from NI to GB of just in time chilled foods does make greater use of the shorter journey time between Dublin and Holyhead (i.e. this specific element may be different)




Number of traders of goods and services by business size and trade partner, 2017


Number of traders of goods and services by trade partner, 2017
