Covid-19 related deaths: week ending 1 July 2022

Latest figures published today by NISRA show that 20 deaths involving Covid-19 occurred in Week 26 ending 1 July 2022. The total number of Covid-19 related deaths that occurred up to 1 July 2022 has now reached 4,684. Of these, 3,263 (69.7%) took place in hospital, 986 (21.1%) in care homes and 435 (9.3%) at residential addresses, hospices or other locations.

Separate analysis, based on the date of death registration, shows that the provisional number of total deaths from all causes registered in Northern Ireland in the week ending 1 July 2022 (week 26 2022) was 347, 25 more than in week 25 of 2022 and 65 more than the 5-year average (2017-2021) of 282.

Covid-19 was mentioned on the death certificate of 19 (5.5%) of the 347 deaths registered in week 26, nine more than the previous week (10). The total number of Covid-19 related deaths registered since the start of the pandemic is 4,674 up to 1 July 2022.

Persons aged 75 and over accounted for 73.9% of the 4,674 Covid-19 related deaths registered between 19 March 2020 and 1 July 2022.
